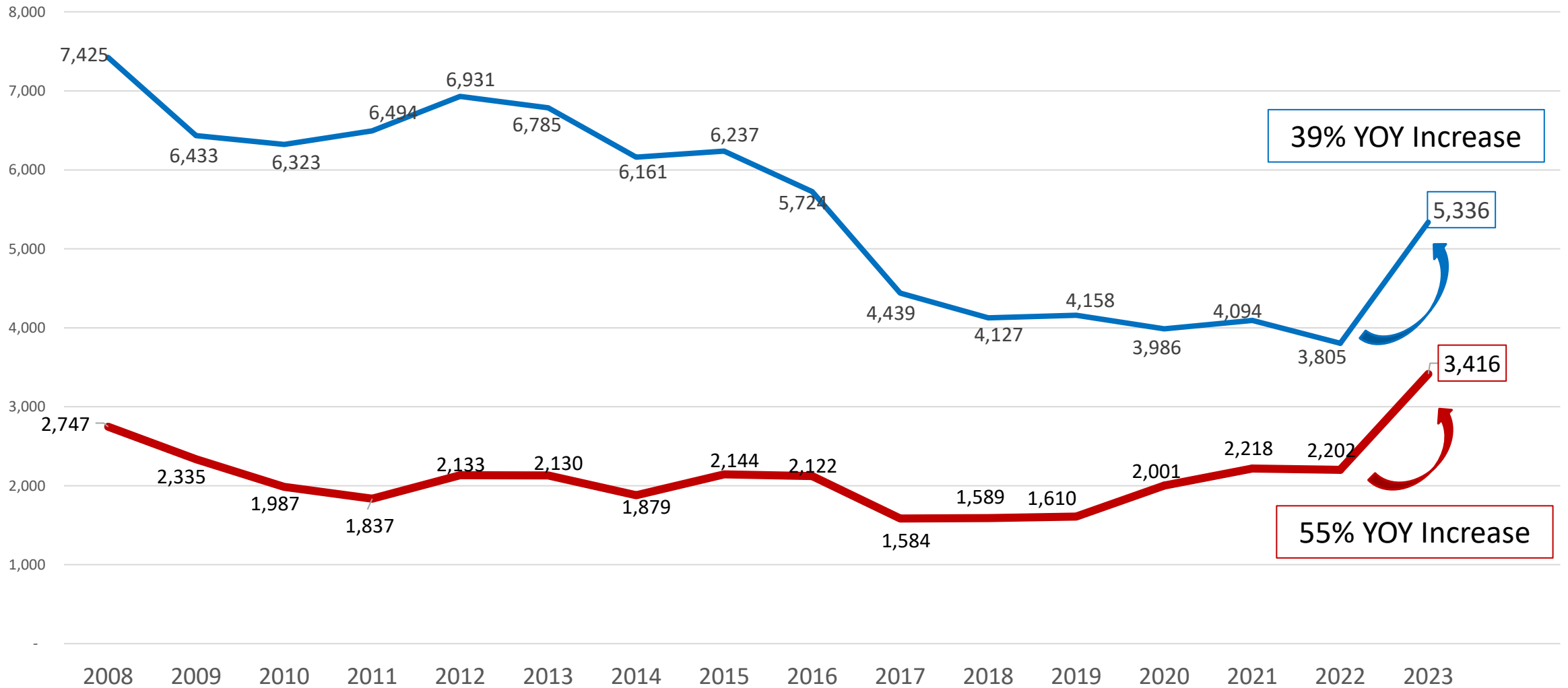

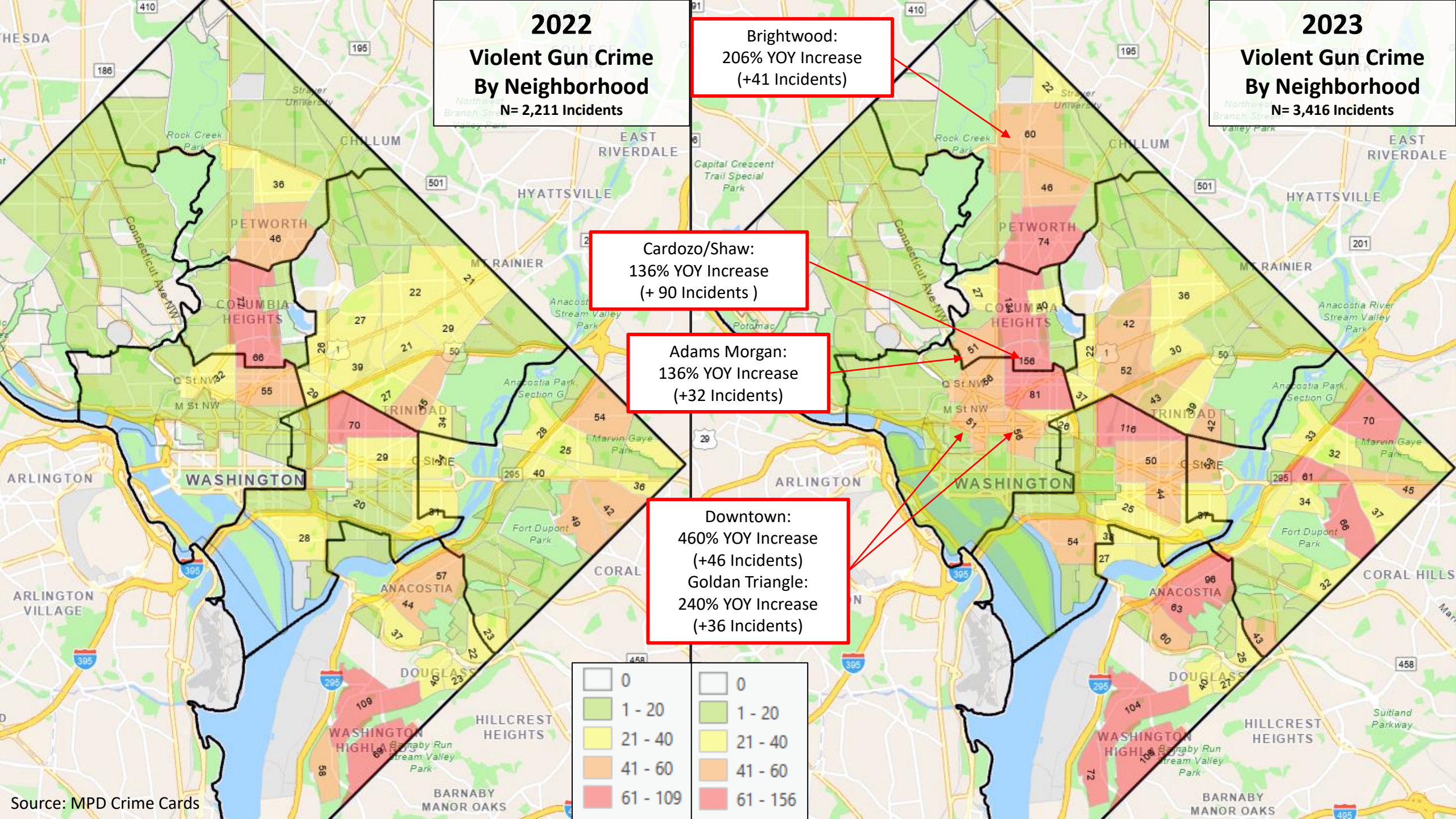
# Violent Crime and Violent Gun Crime Counts By Year: 2008-2023



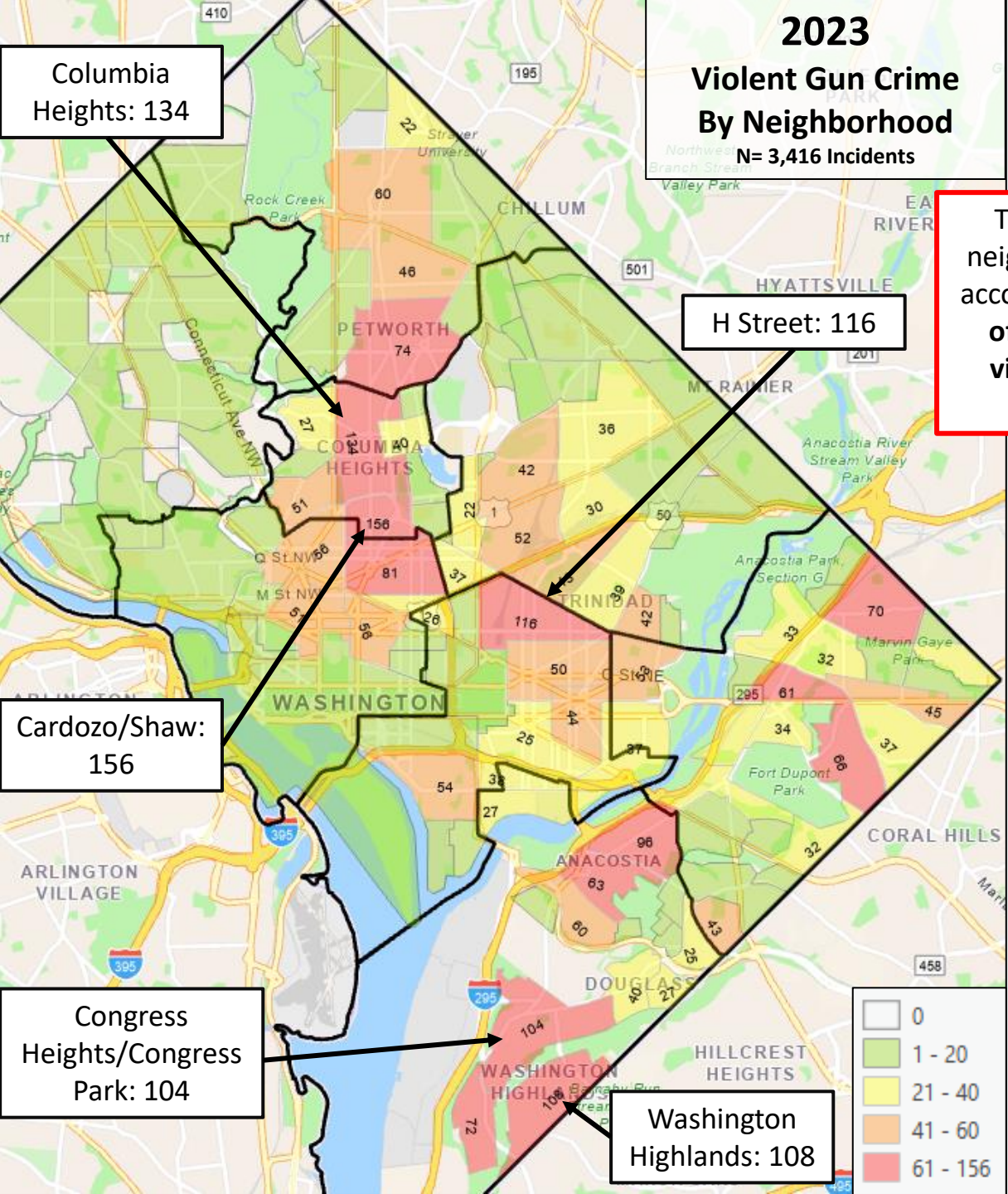

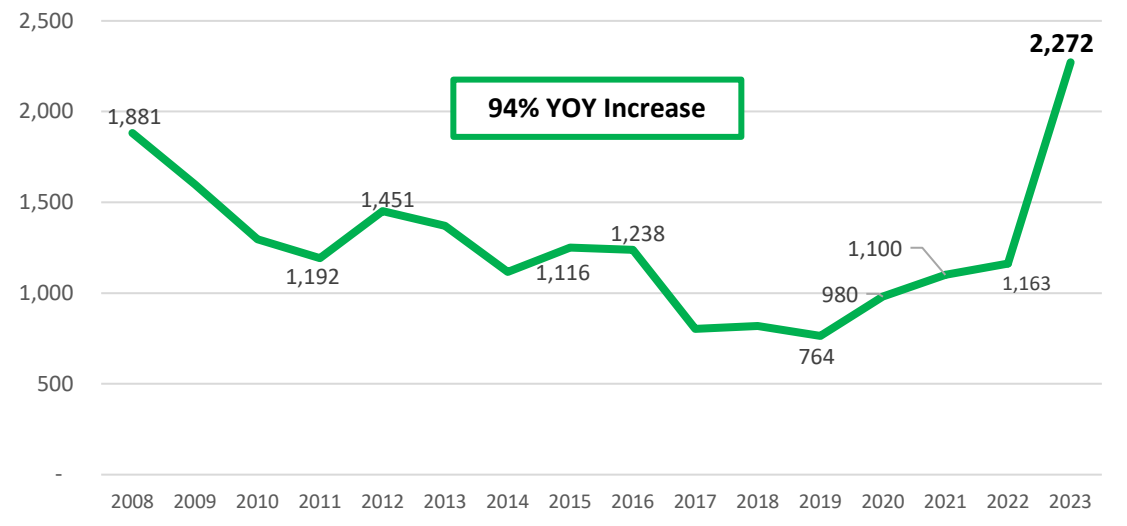

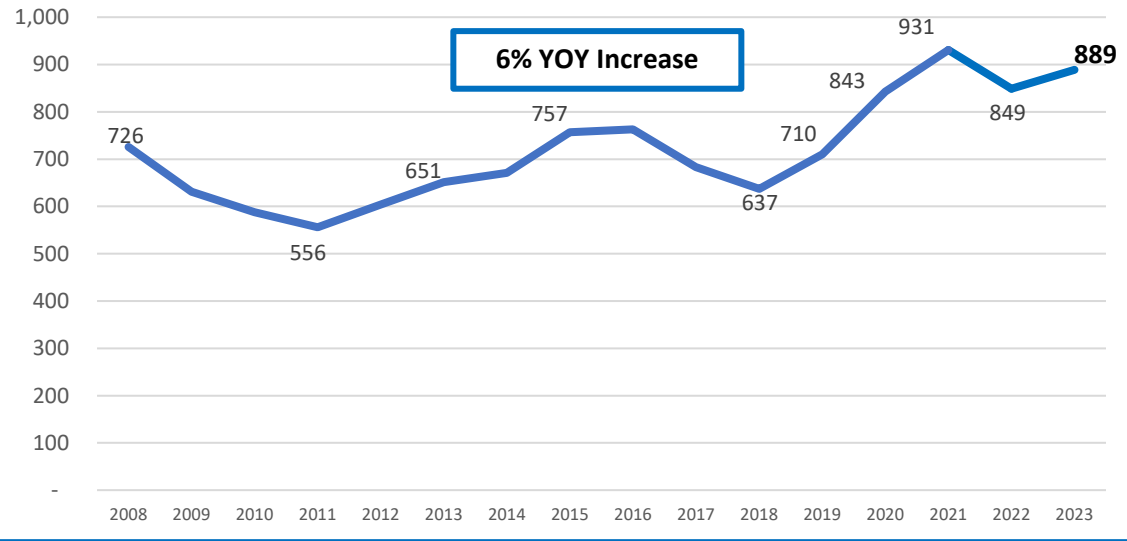
### Robbery Gun Counts By Year: 2008-2023



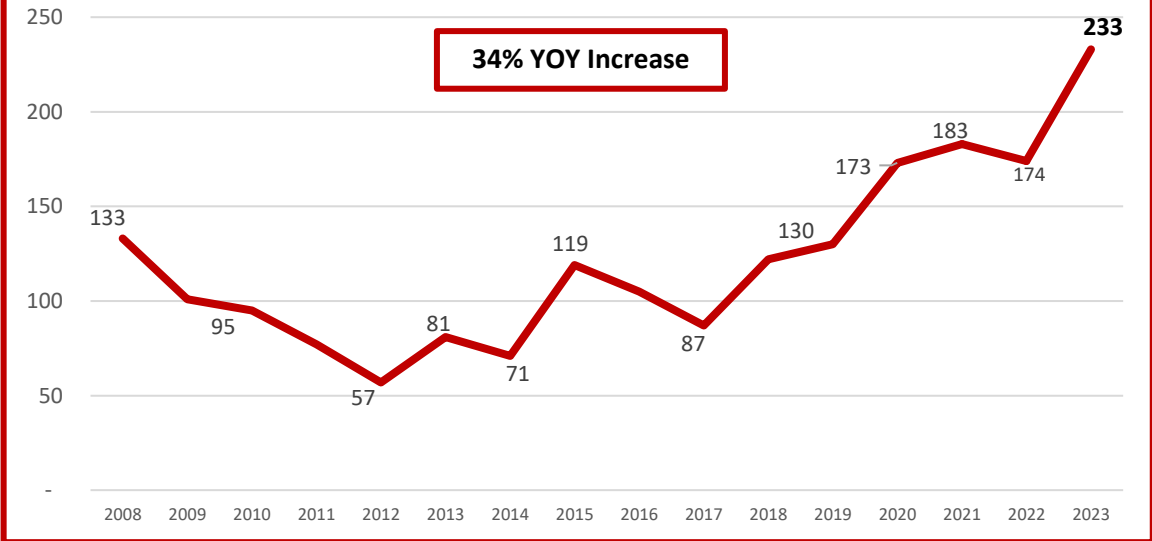
### Homicide Counts By Year: 2008-2023



### ADW Gun Counts By Year: 2008-2023

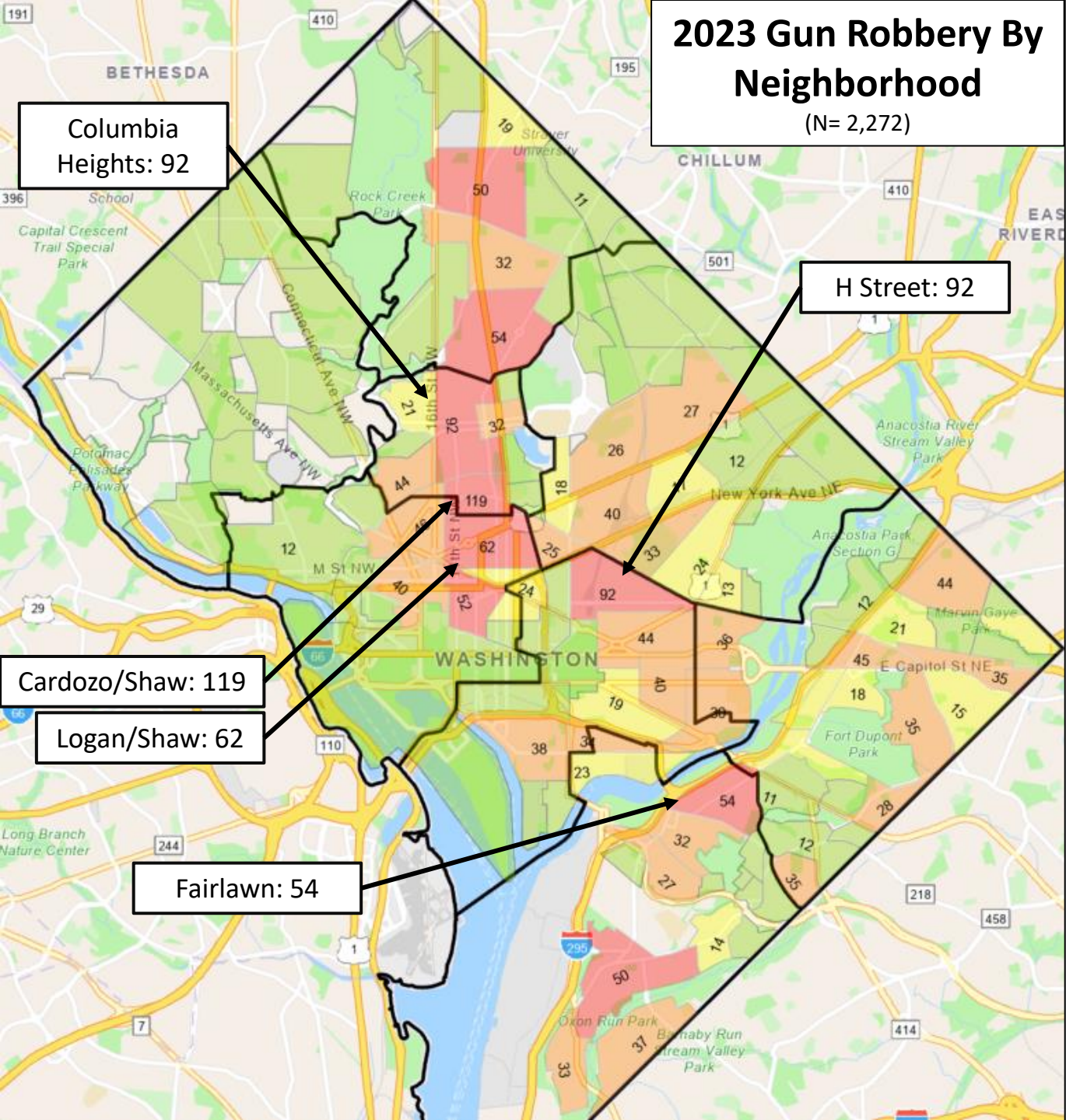


### Homicide Gun Counts By Year: 2008-2022

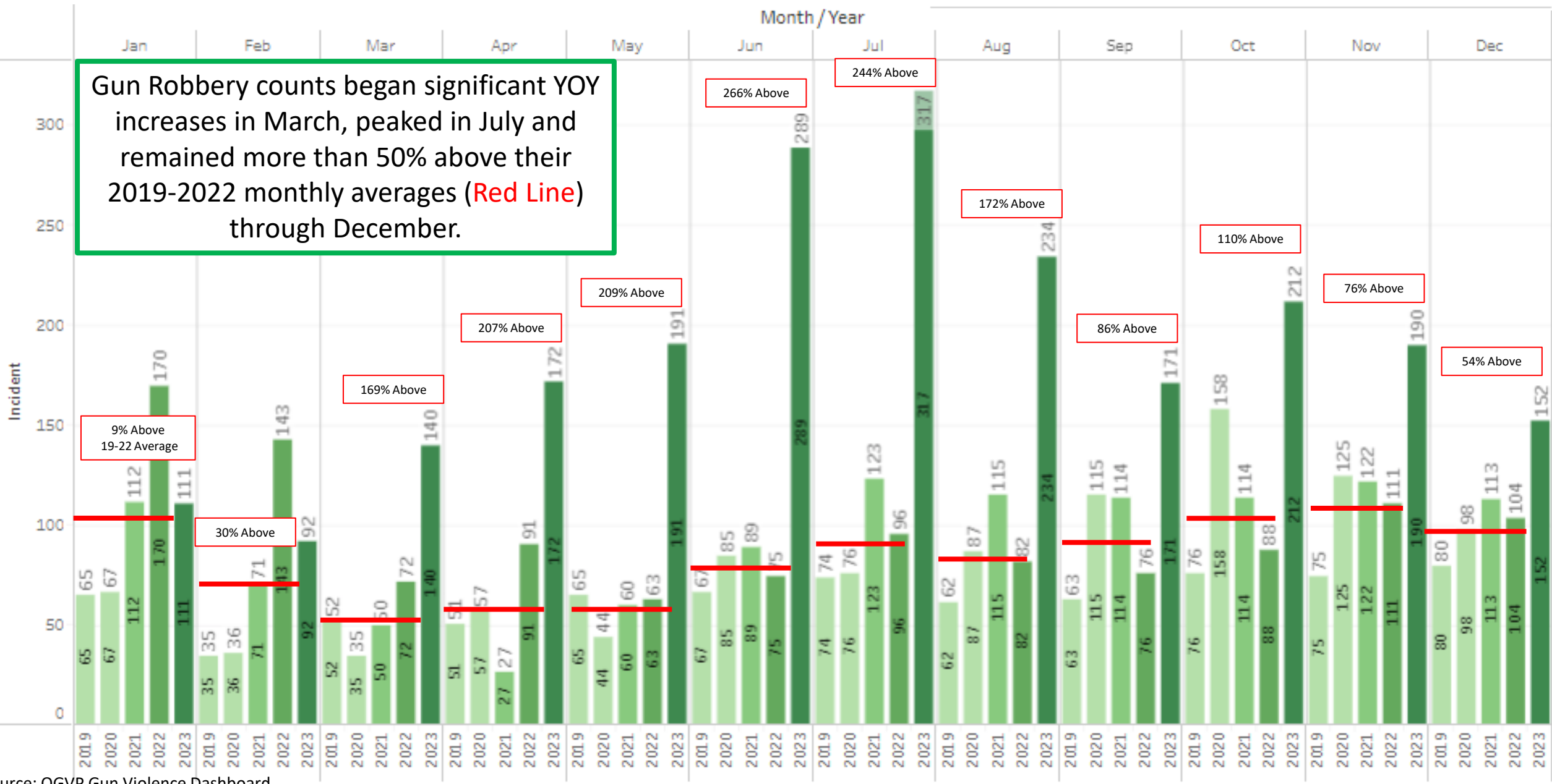

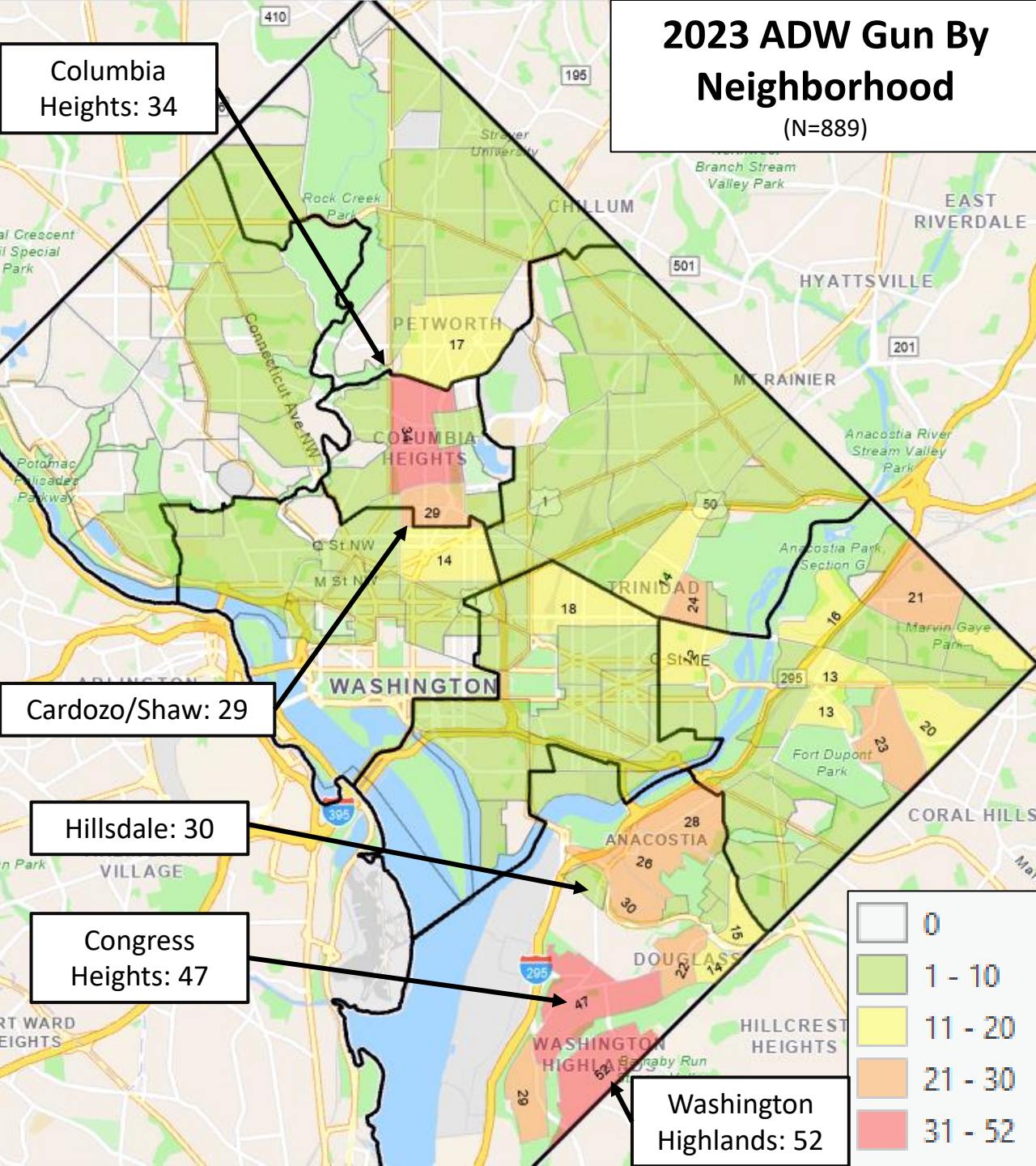
# Gun Robbery By Month: 2019-2023

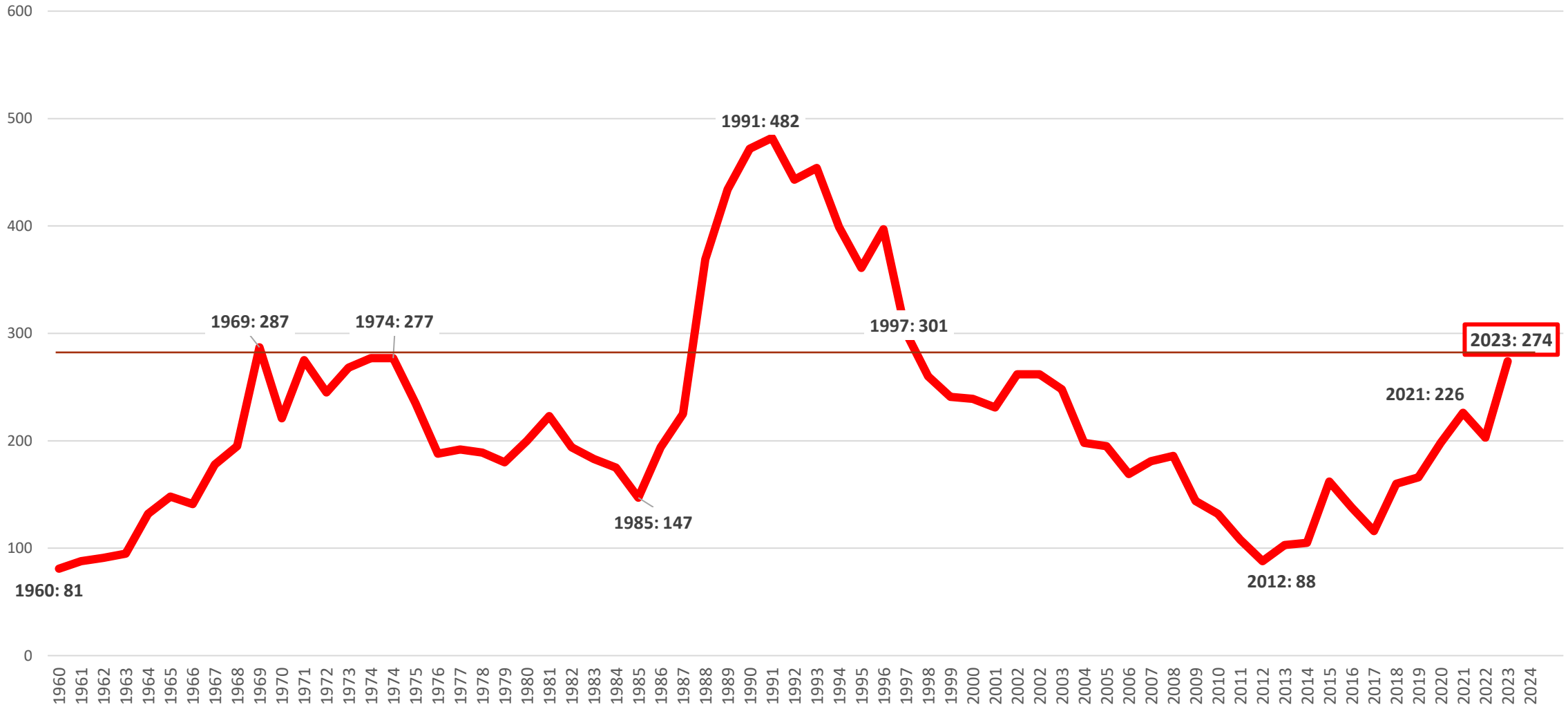

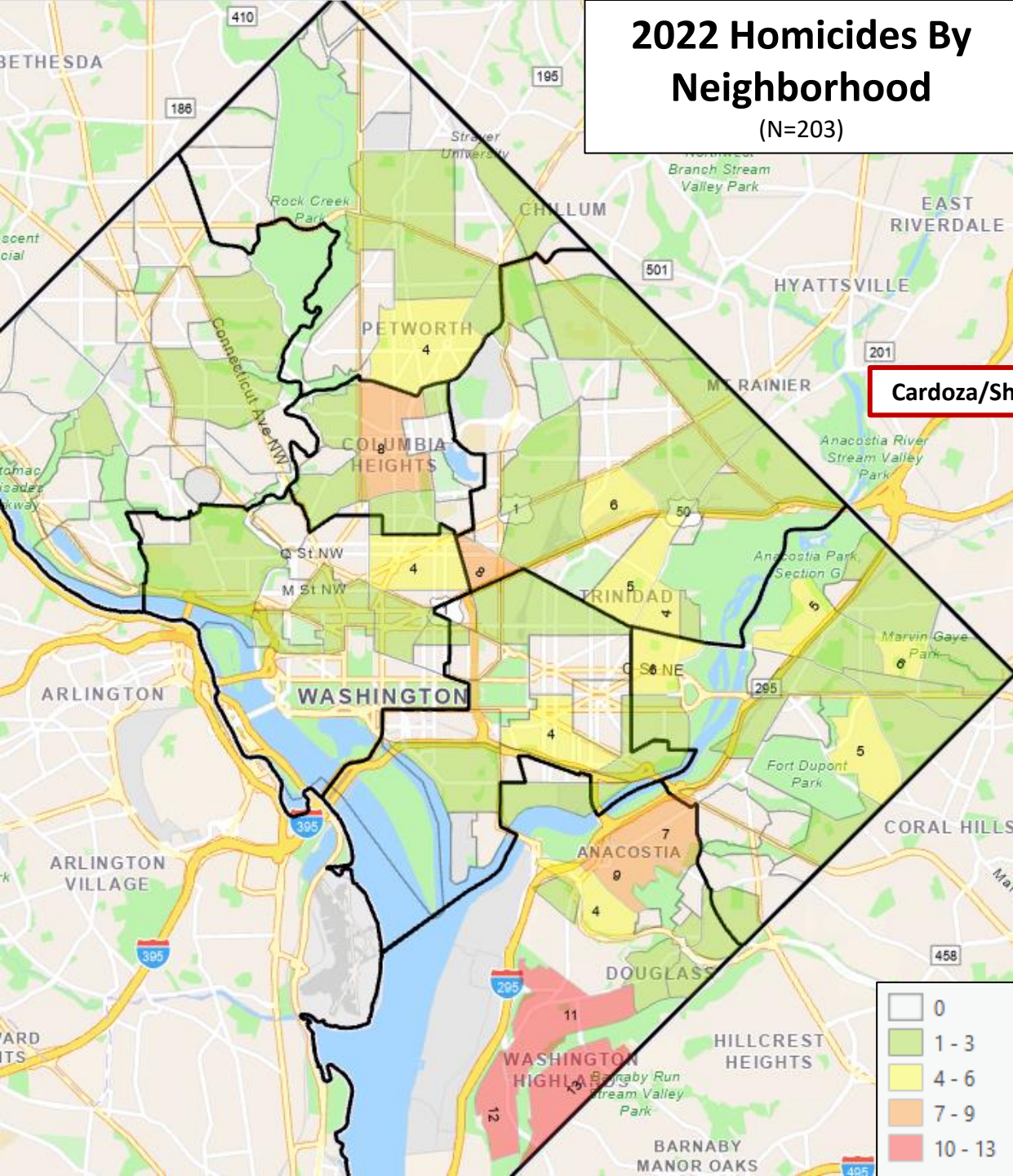

## Homicides By Year: 1960-2023

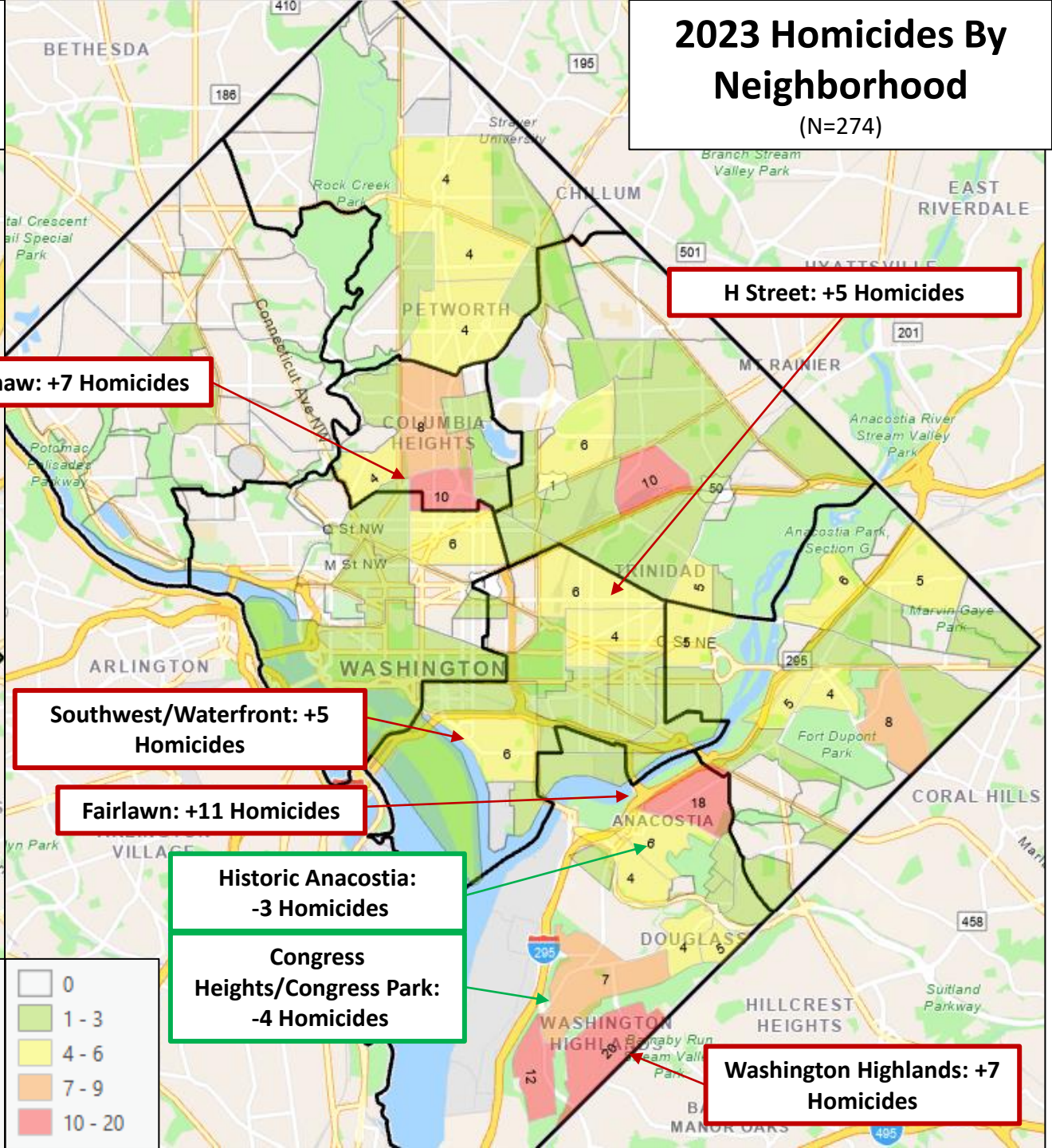

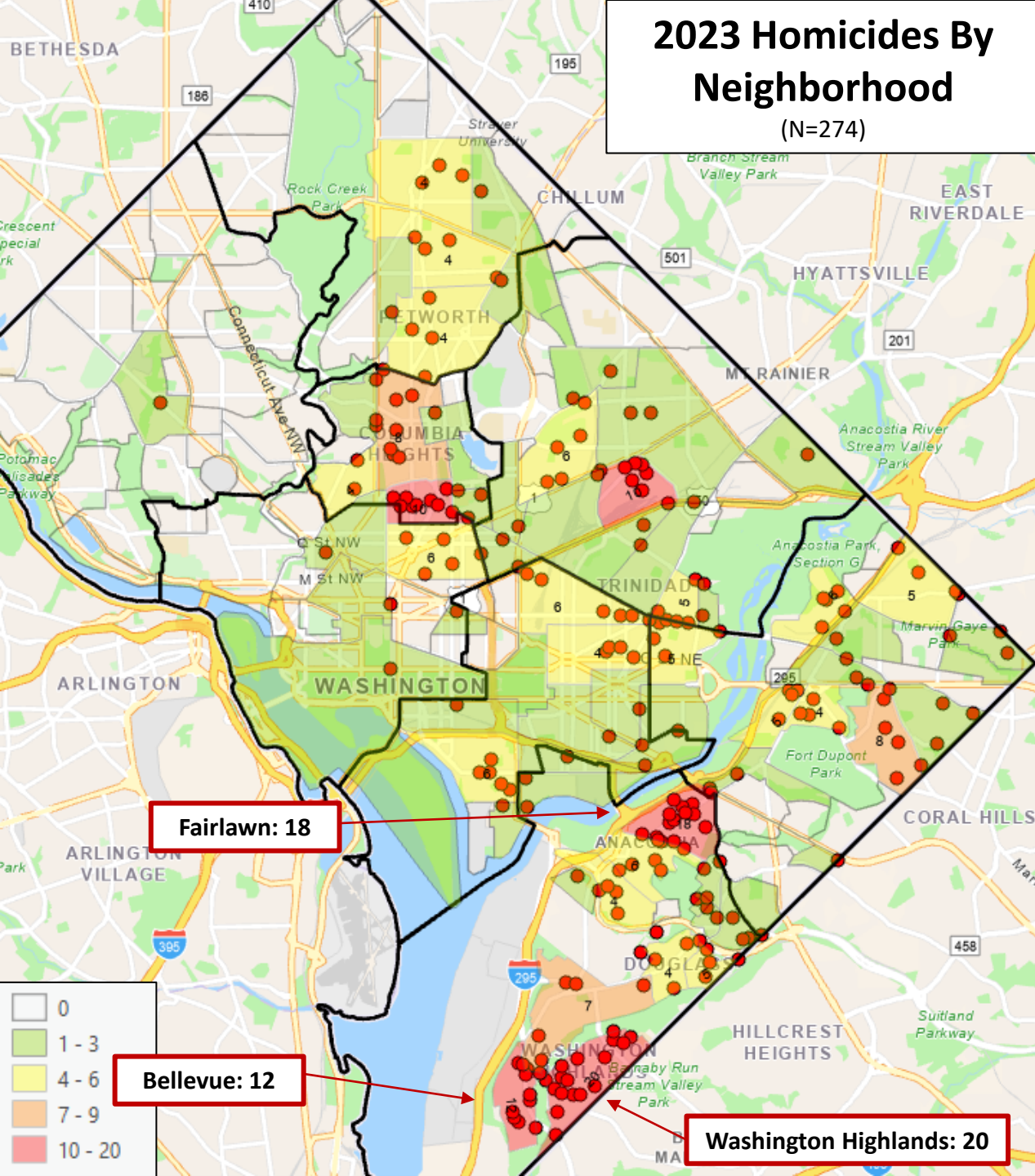

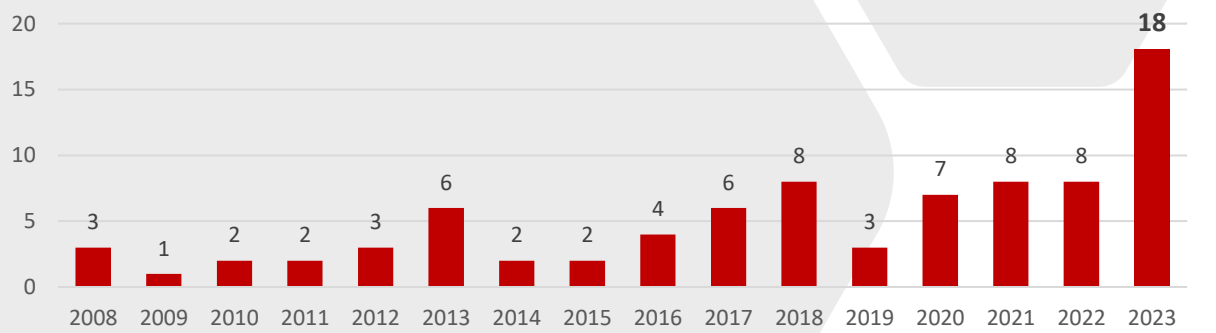

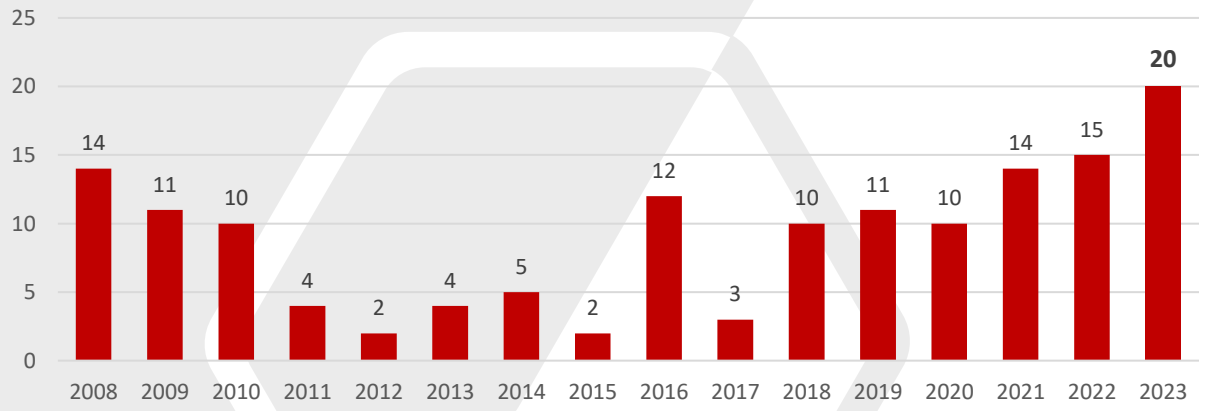
### Homicides In Bellevue 2008-2023



### Homicides In Fairlawn 2008-2023



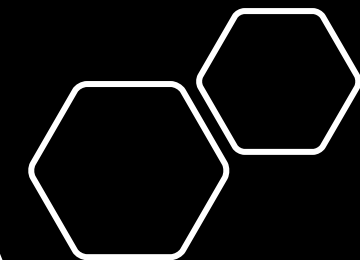

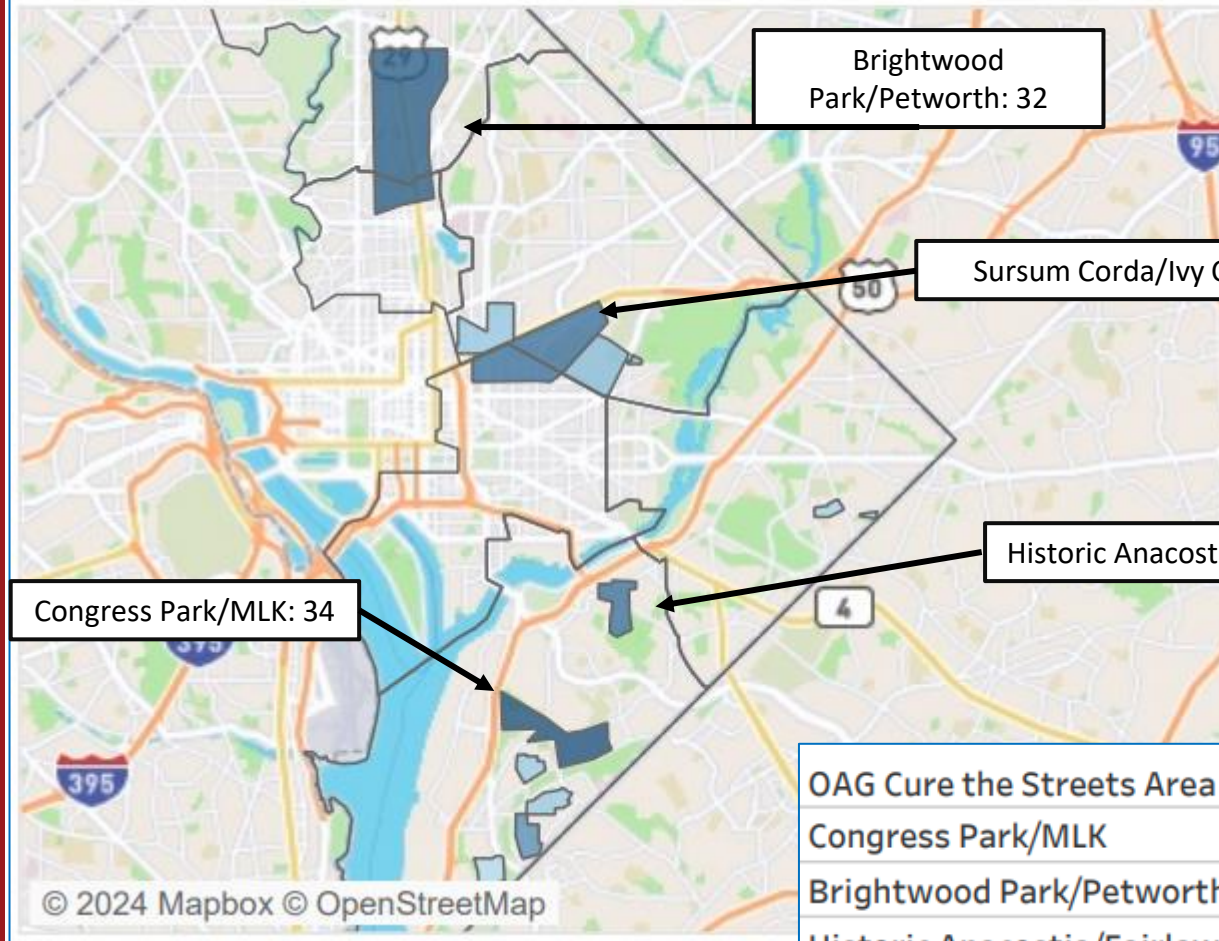

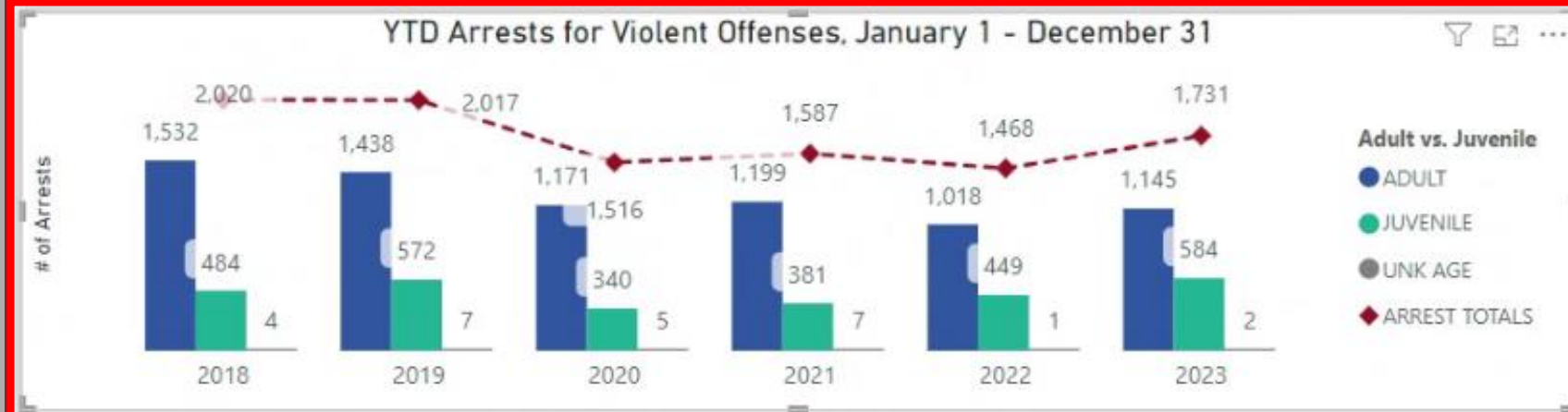

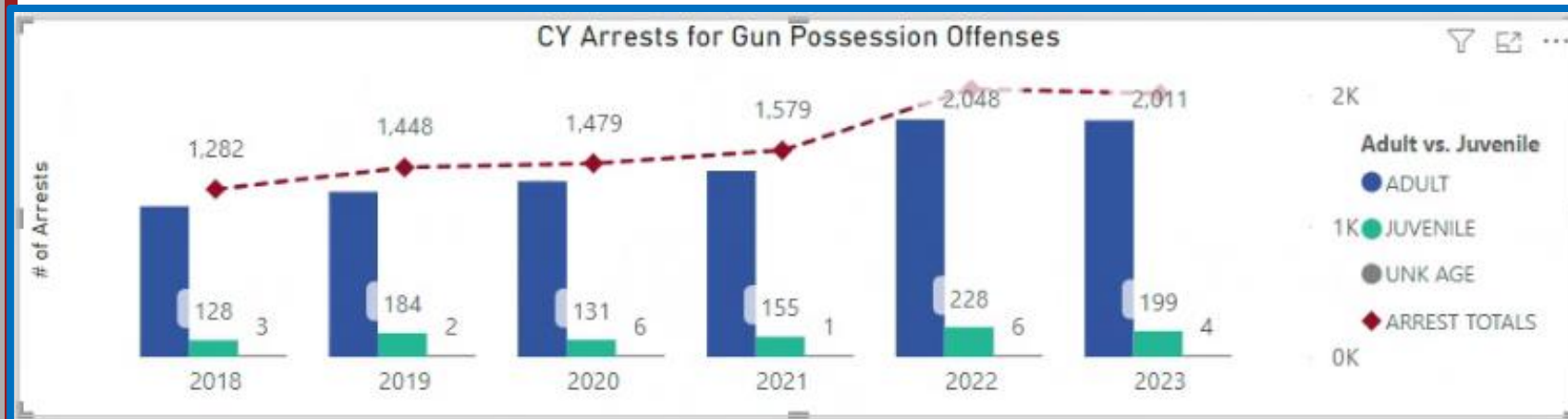
