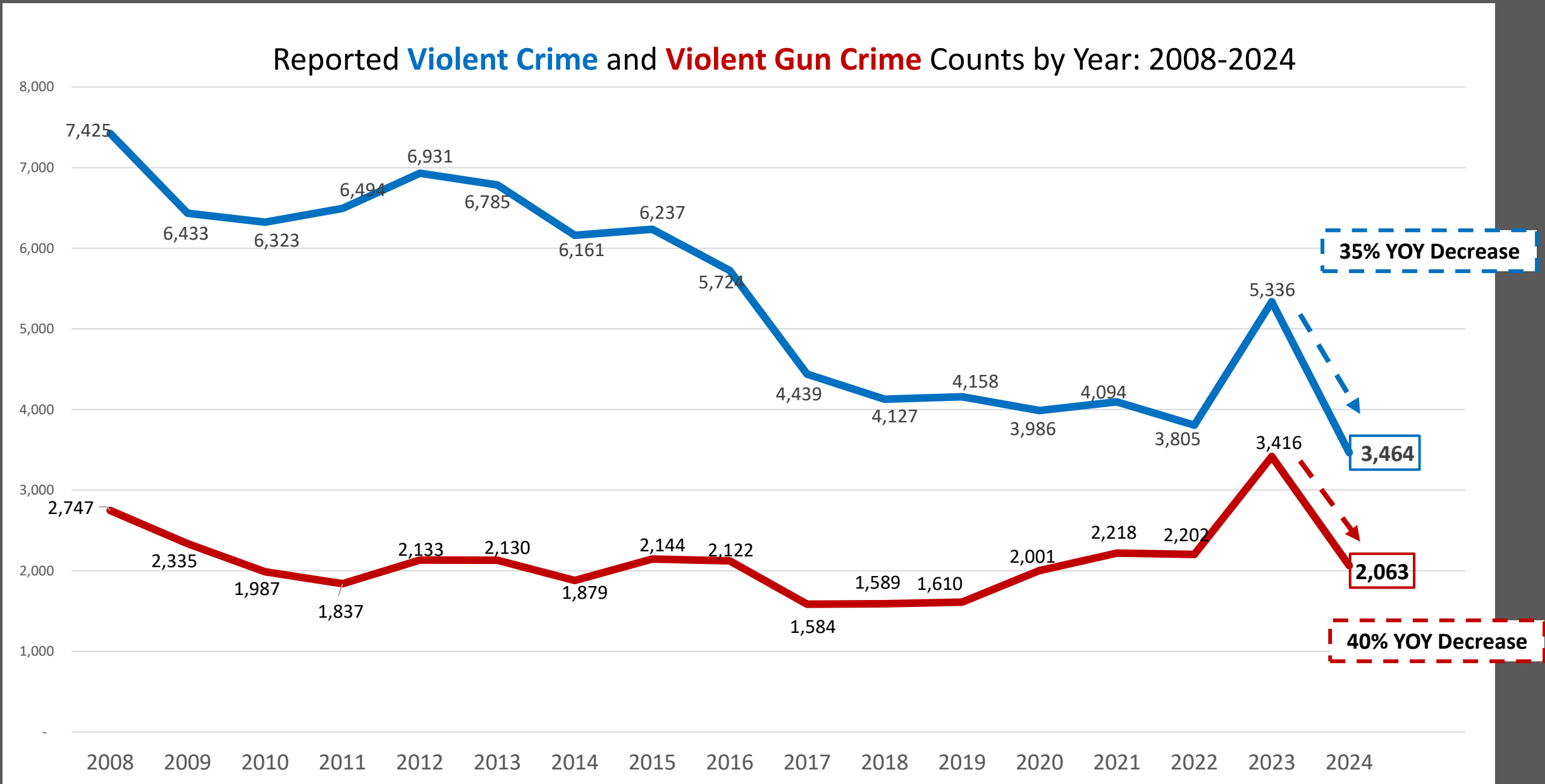

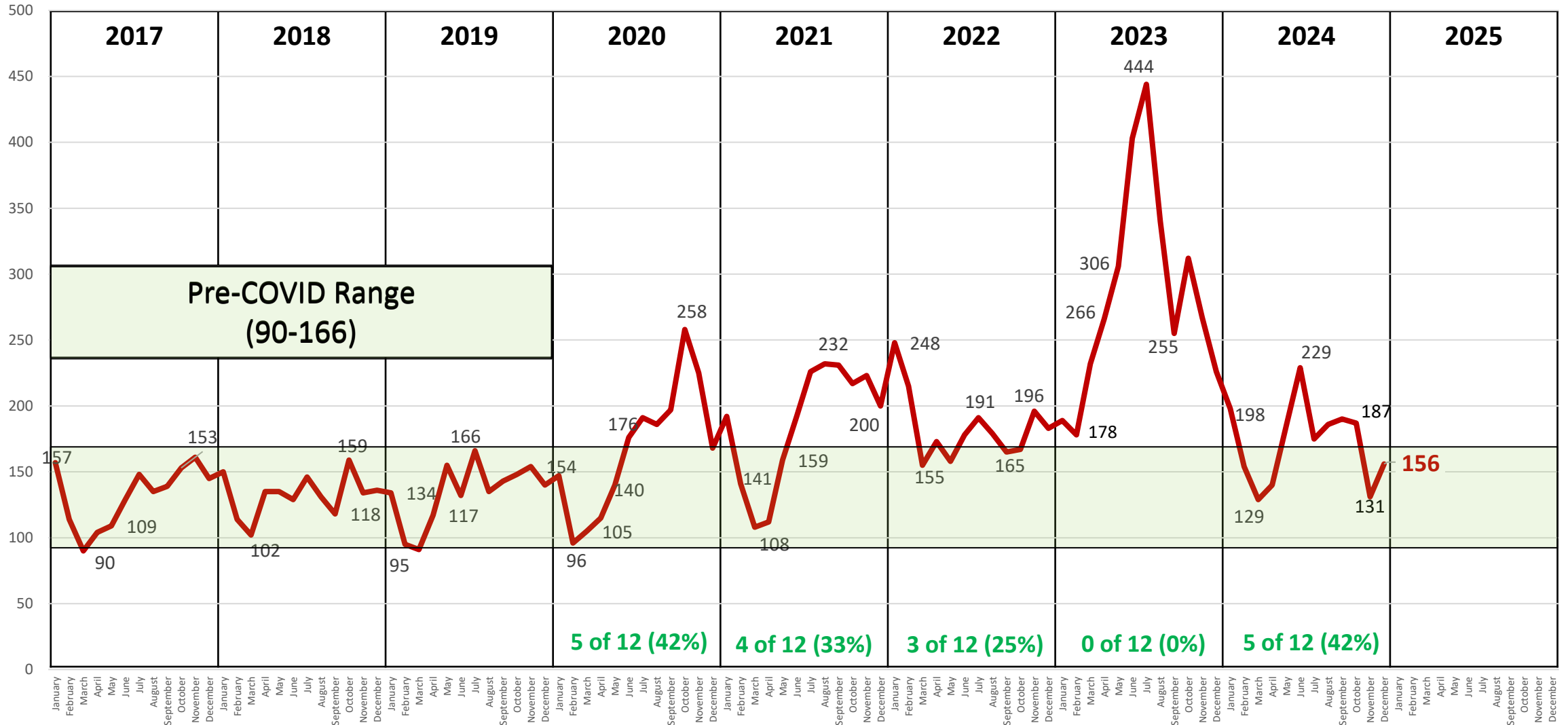

While reported Violent Crime is back within its multi-year downtrend, Violent Gun Crime continues to trend sideways.

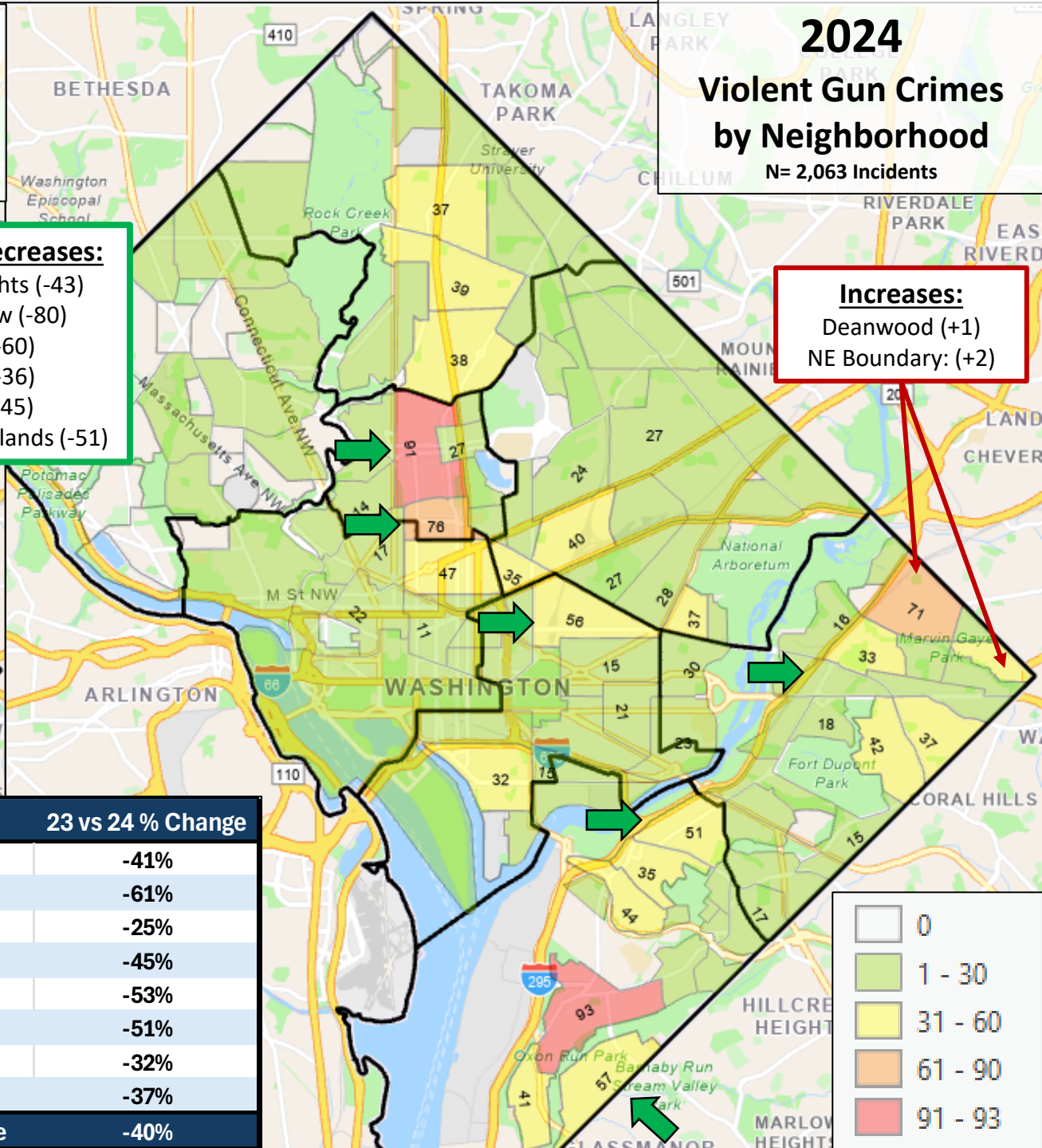
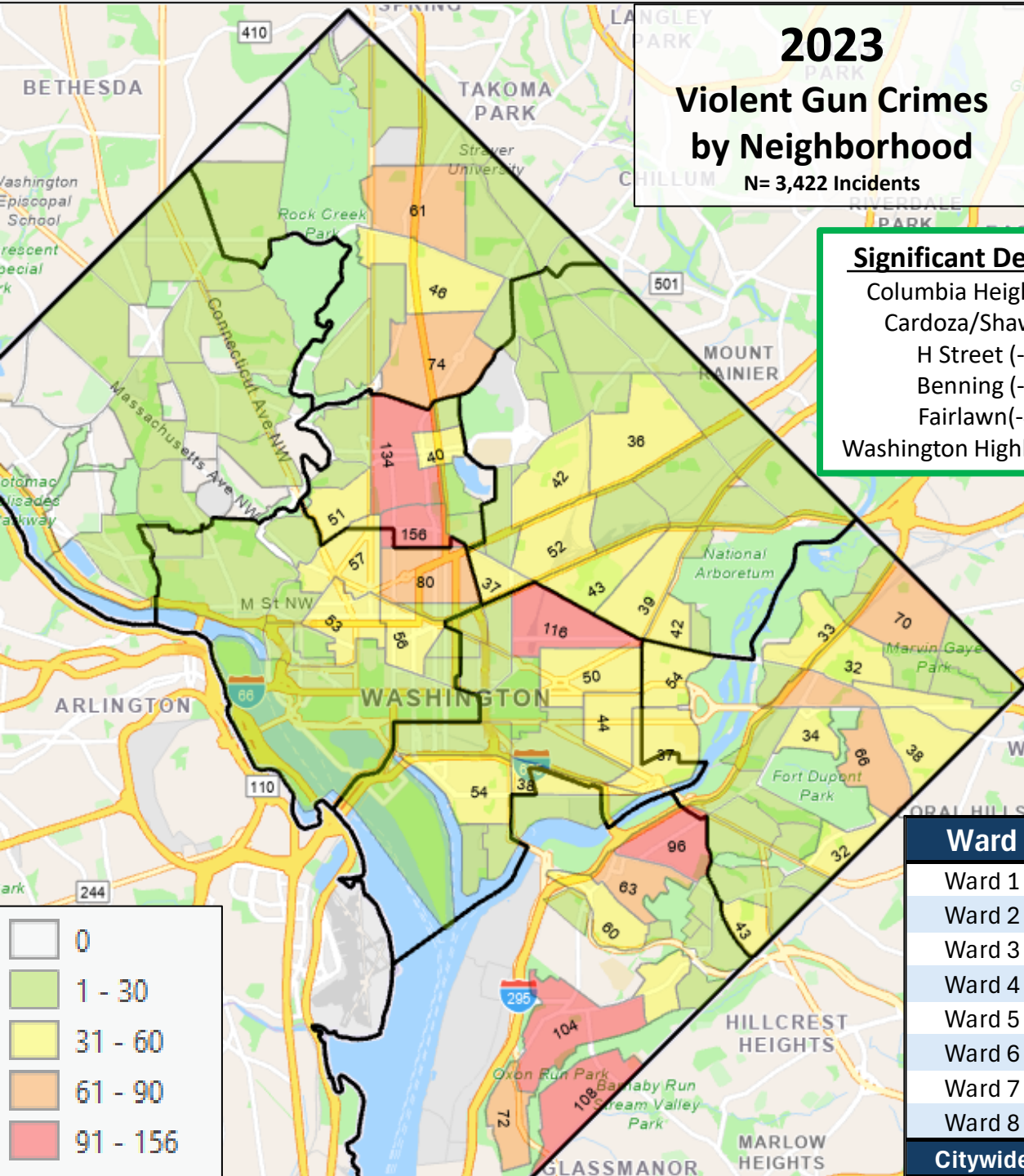

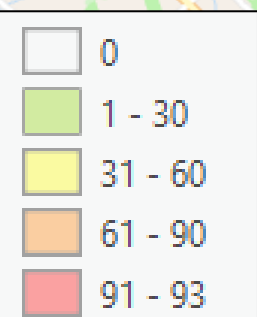
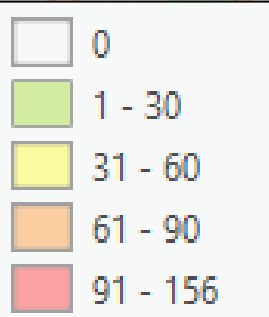
2017-2025 Reported Violent Gun Crime Counts By Month

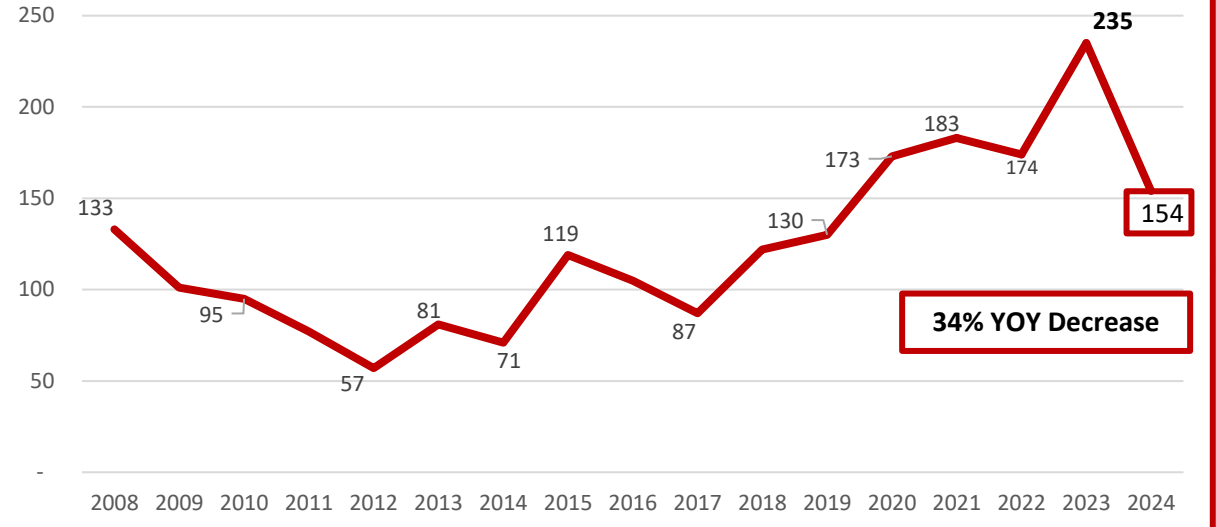

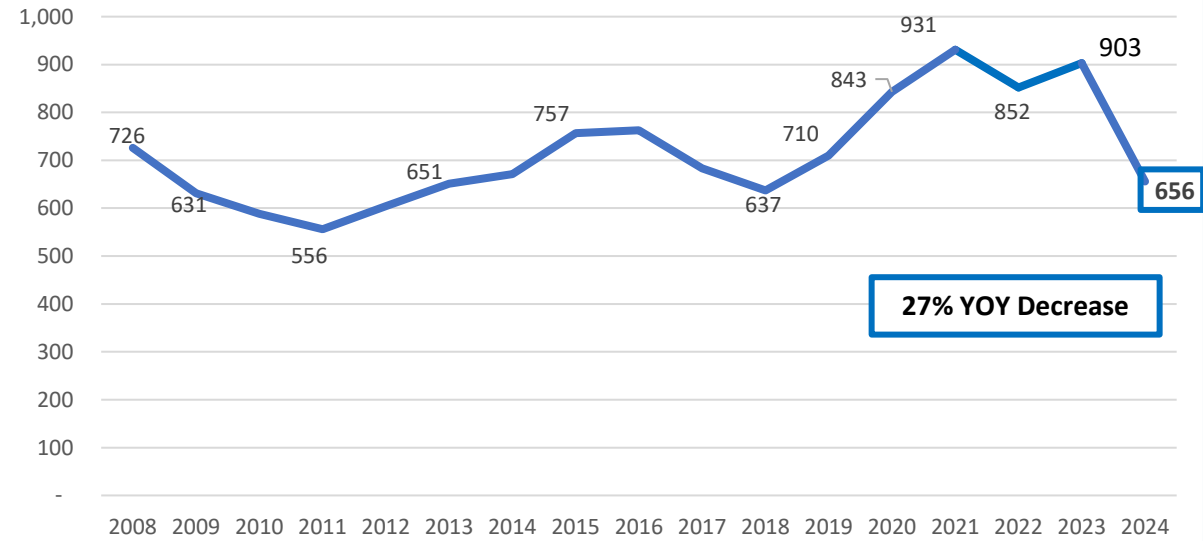
Reported Robbery Gun Counts by Year: 2008-2024



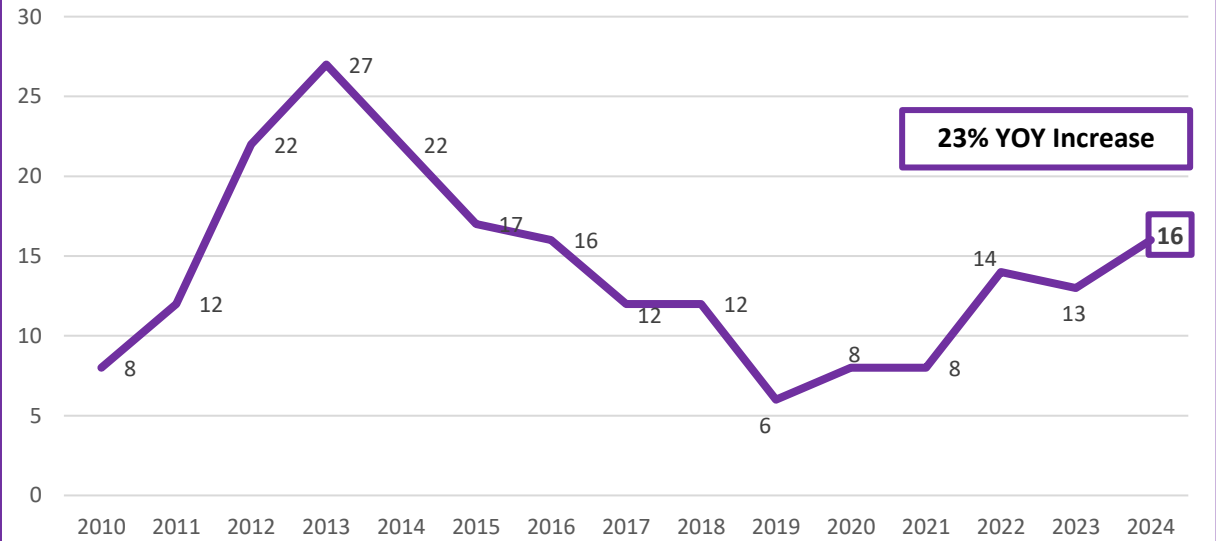
Reported Homicide Gun Counts by Year: 2008-2024

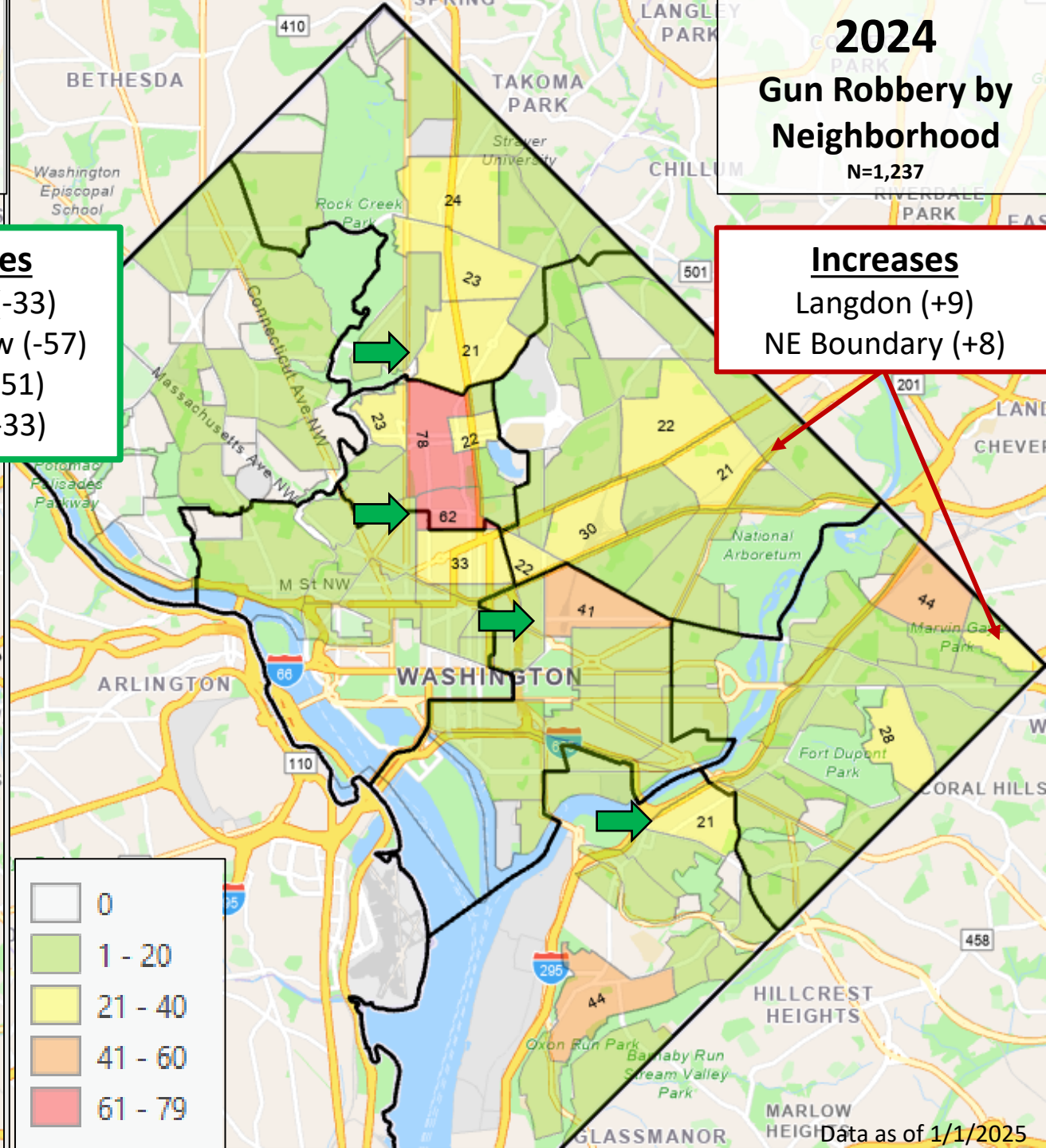
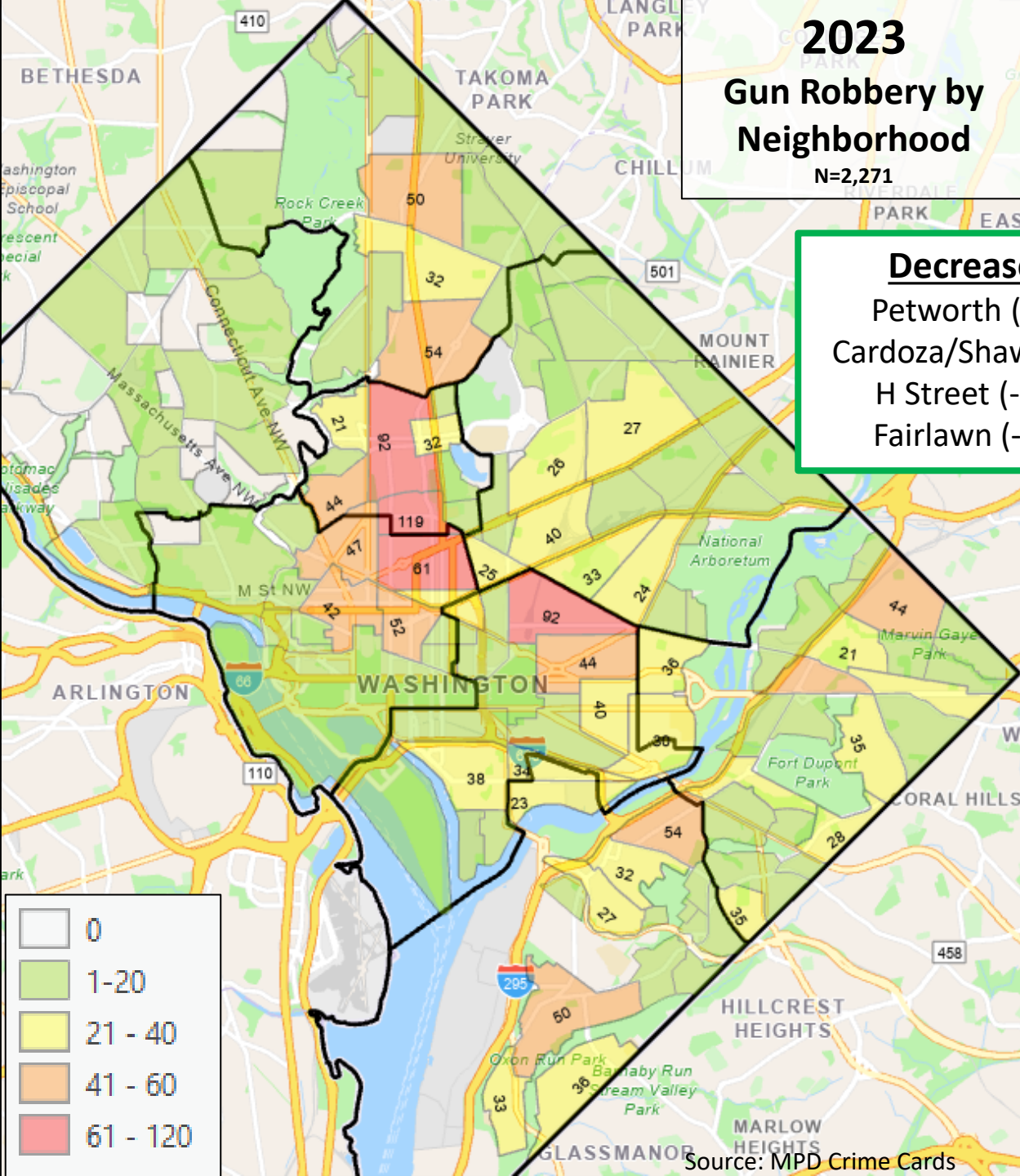


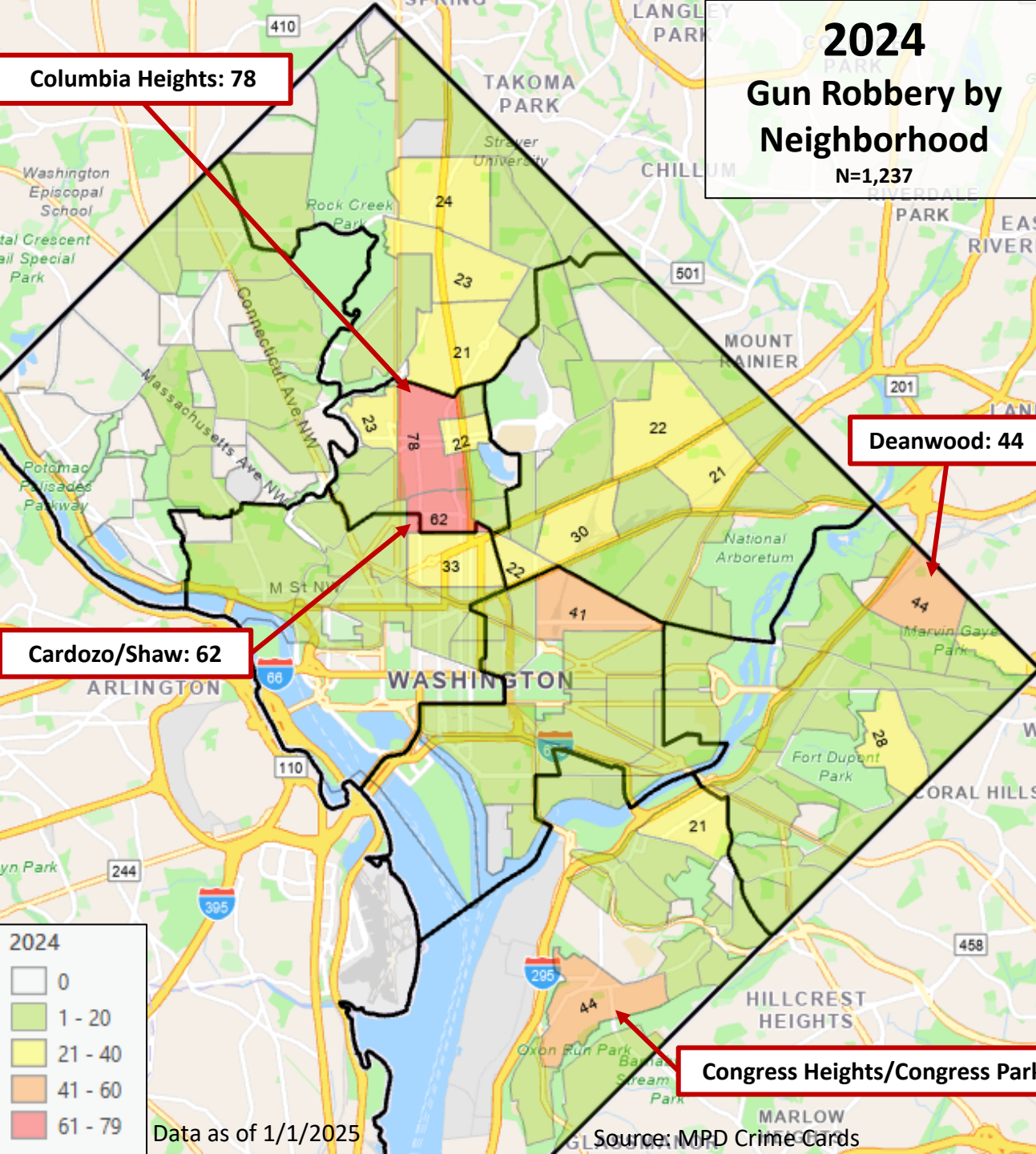
ADW Gun Counts by Year: 2008-2024



Reported Sex Abuse Gun Counts by Year: 2008-2024



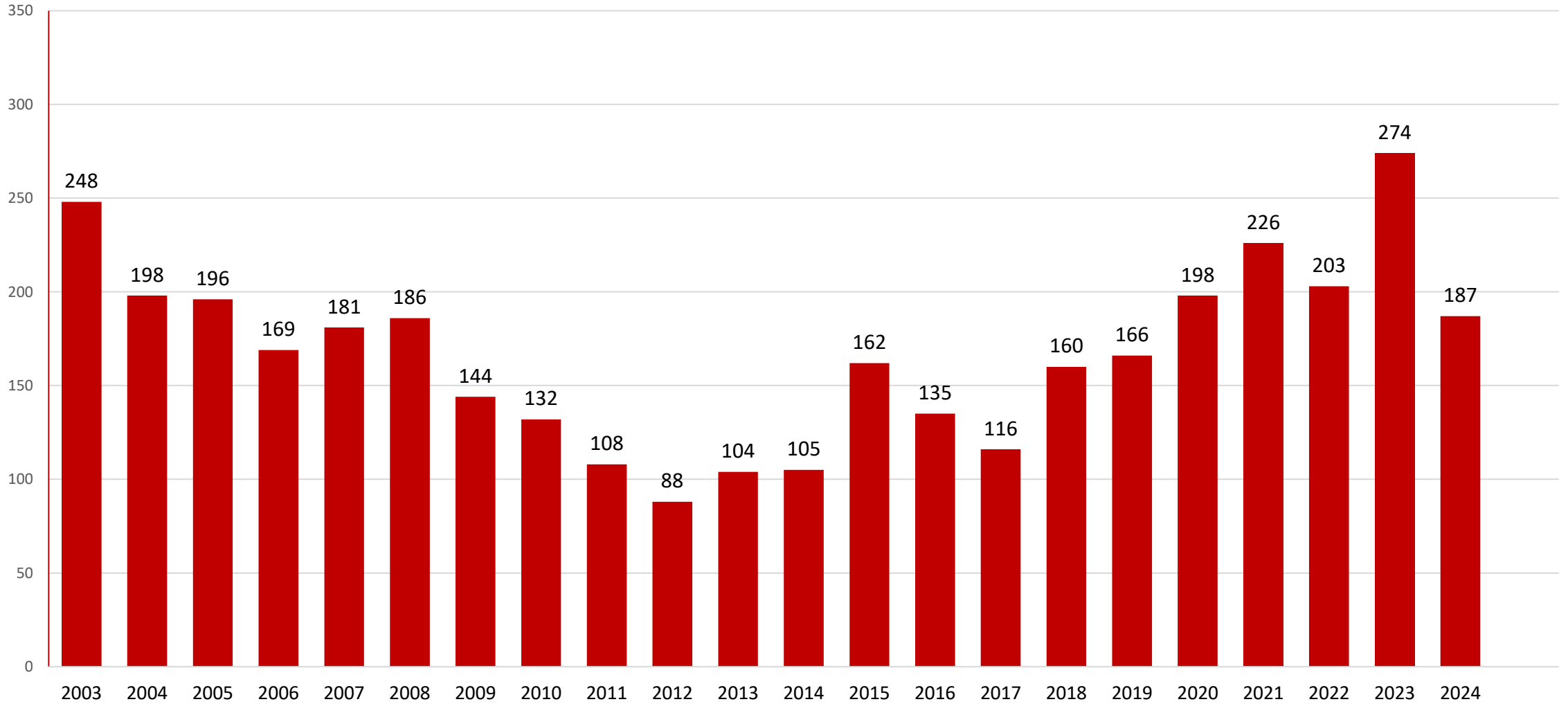


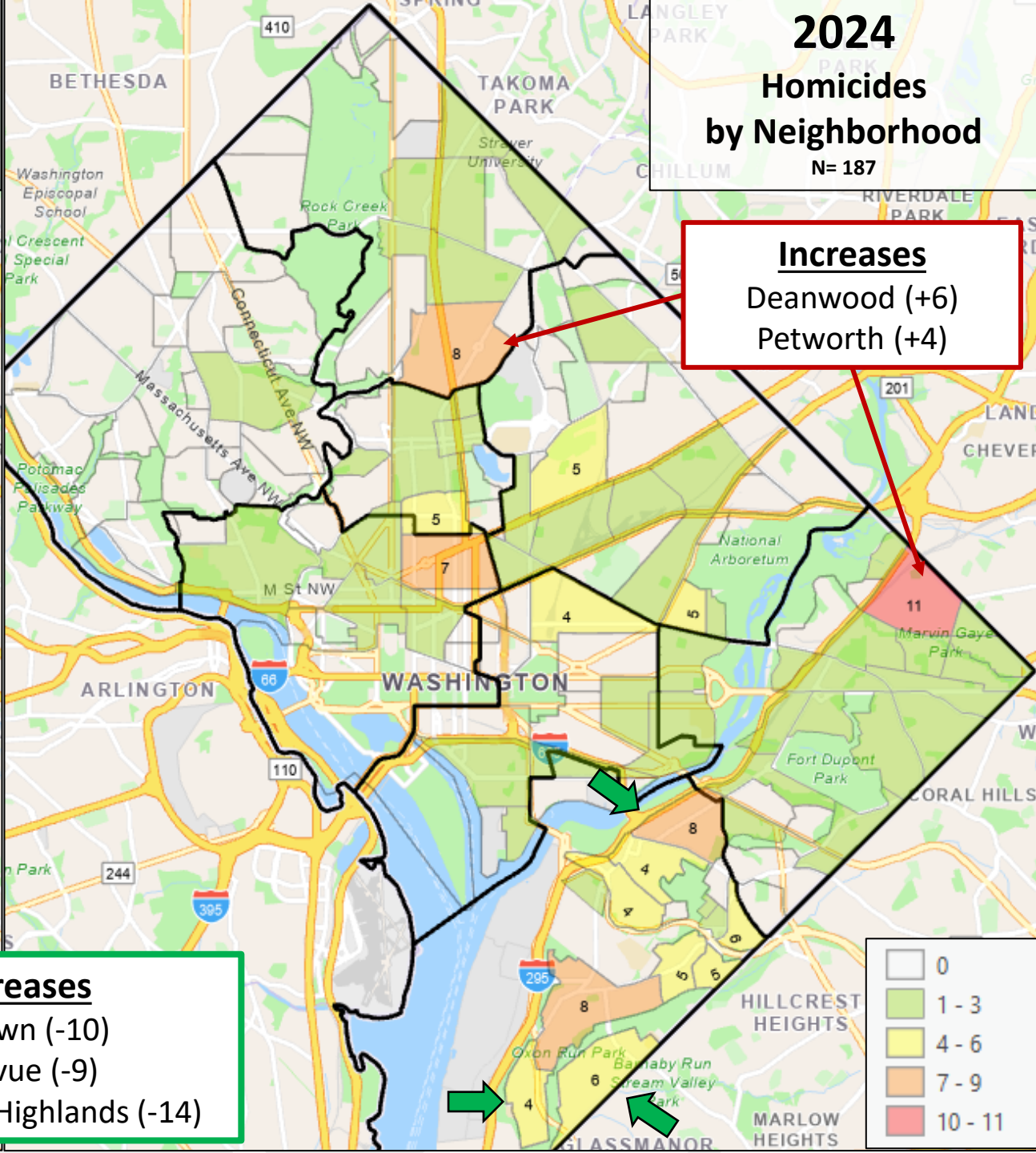
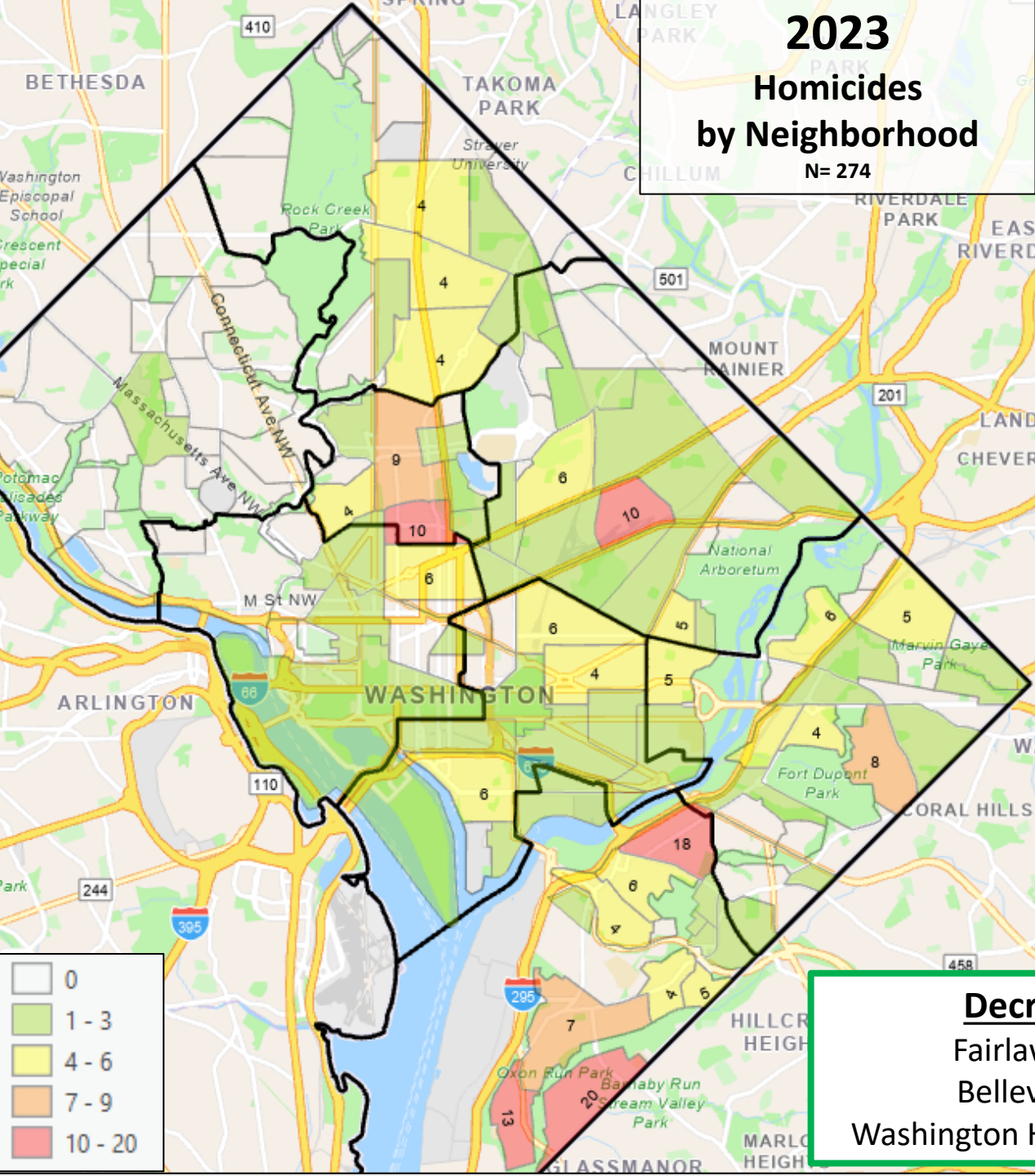

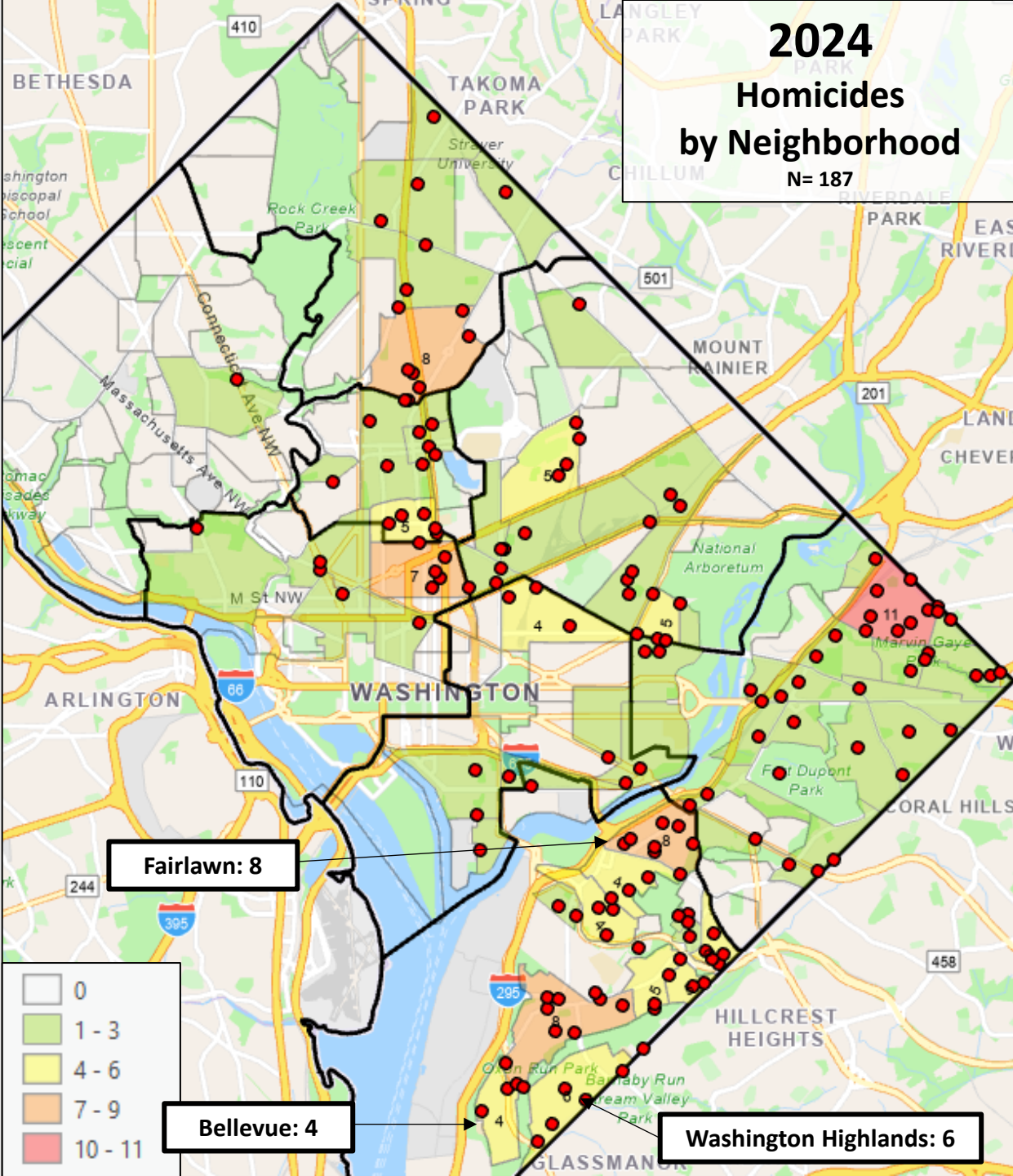




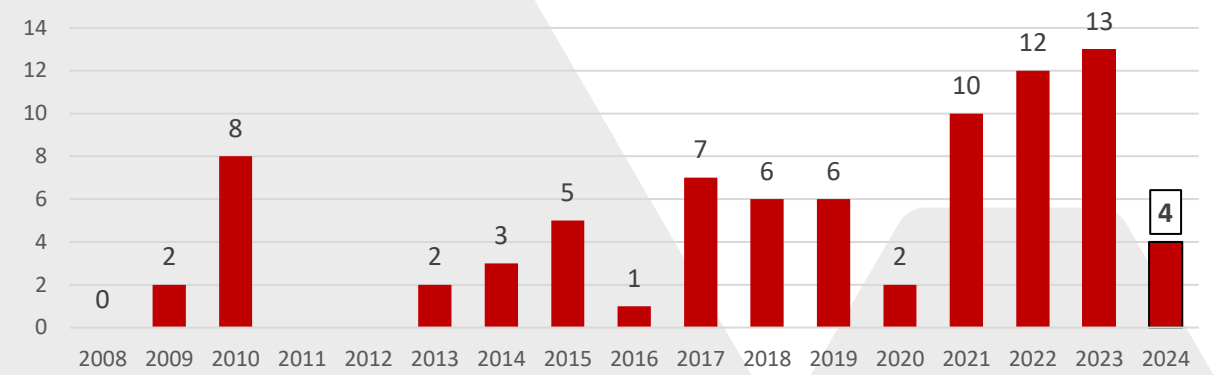

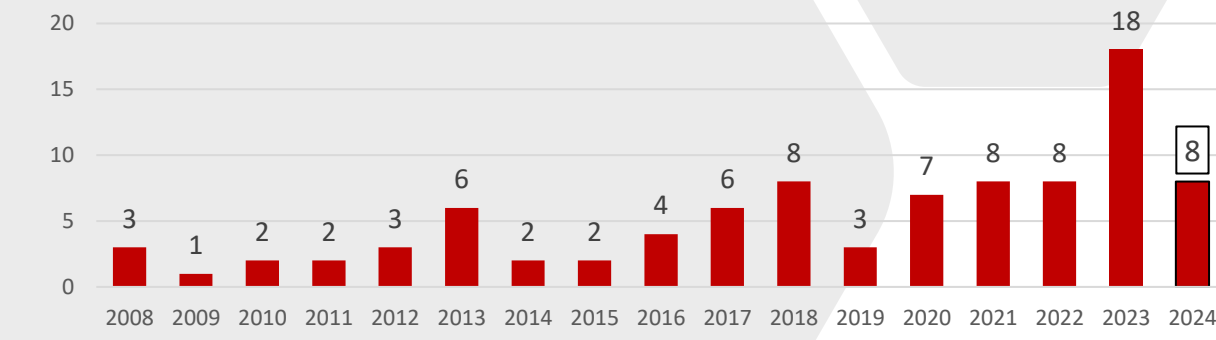




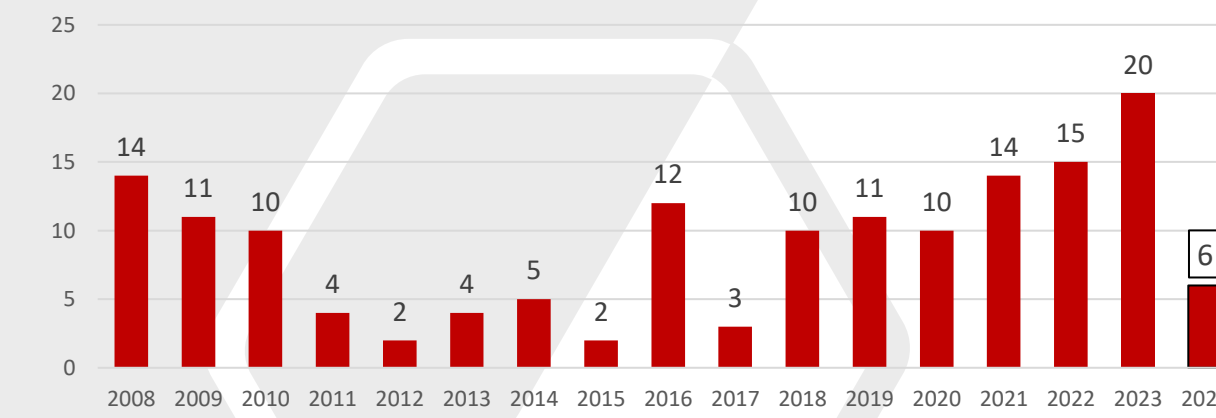
Homicides in Bellevue 2008-2024

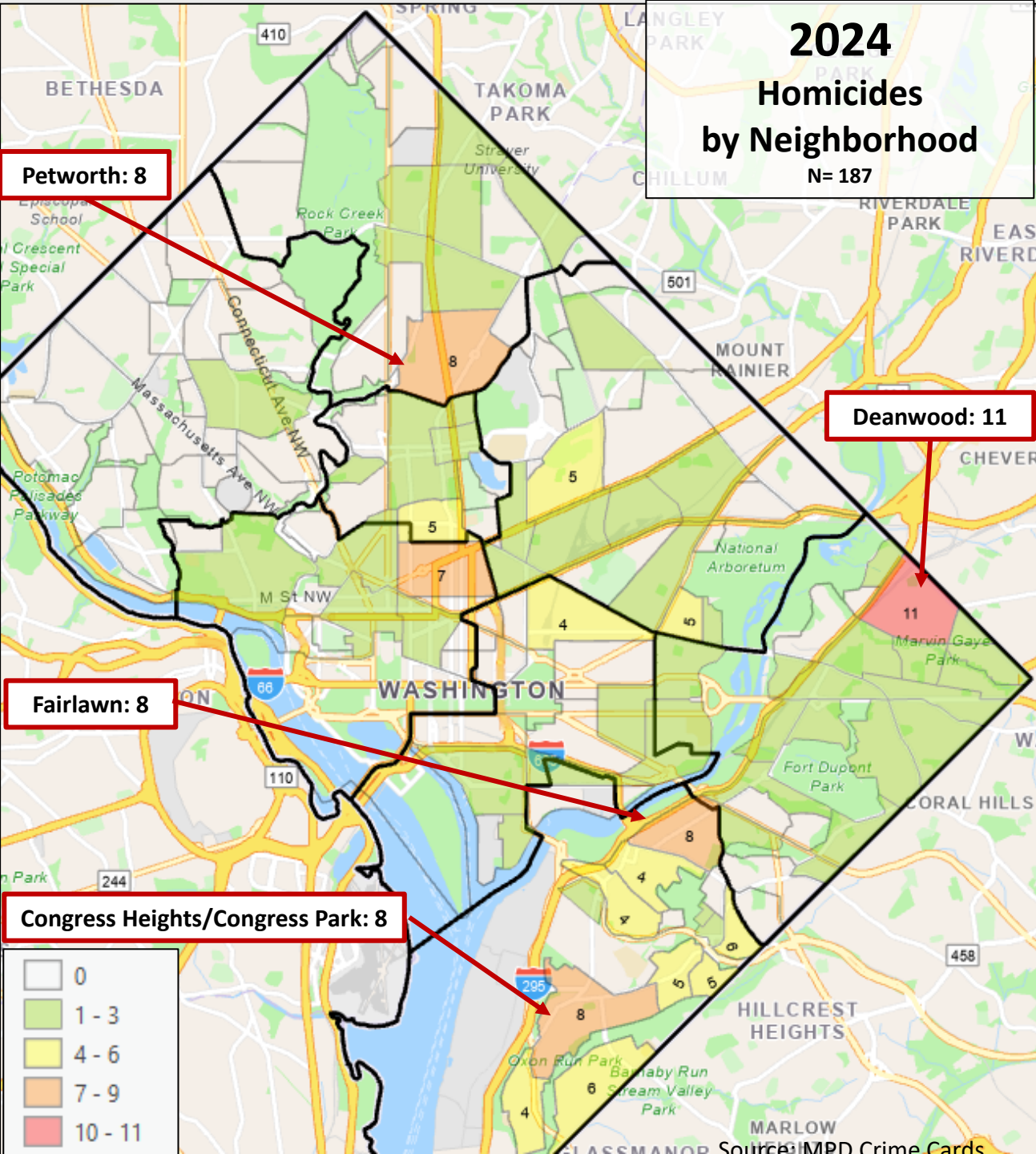


Homicides in Fairlawn 2008-2024

Both Violent Crime and Violent Gun Crime counts are down year-over-year and when compared to 2022.

Gun Robbery is down from its multi-decade high in 2023 but counts remain above pre-covid levels.
