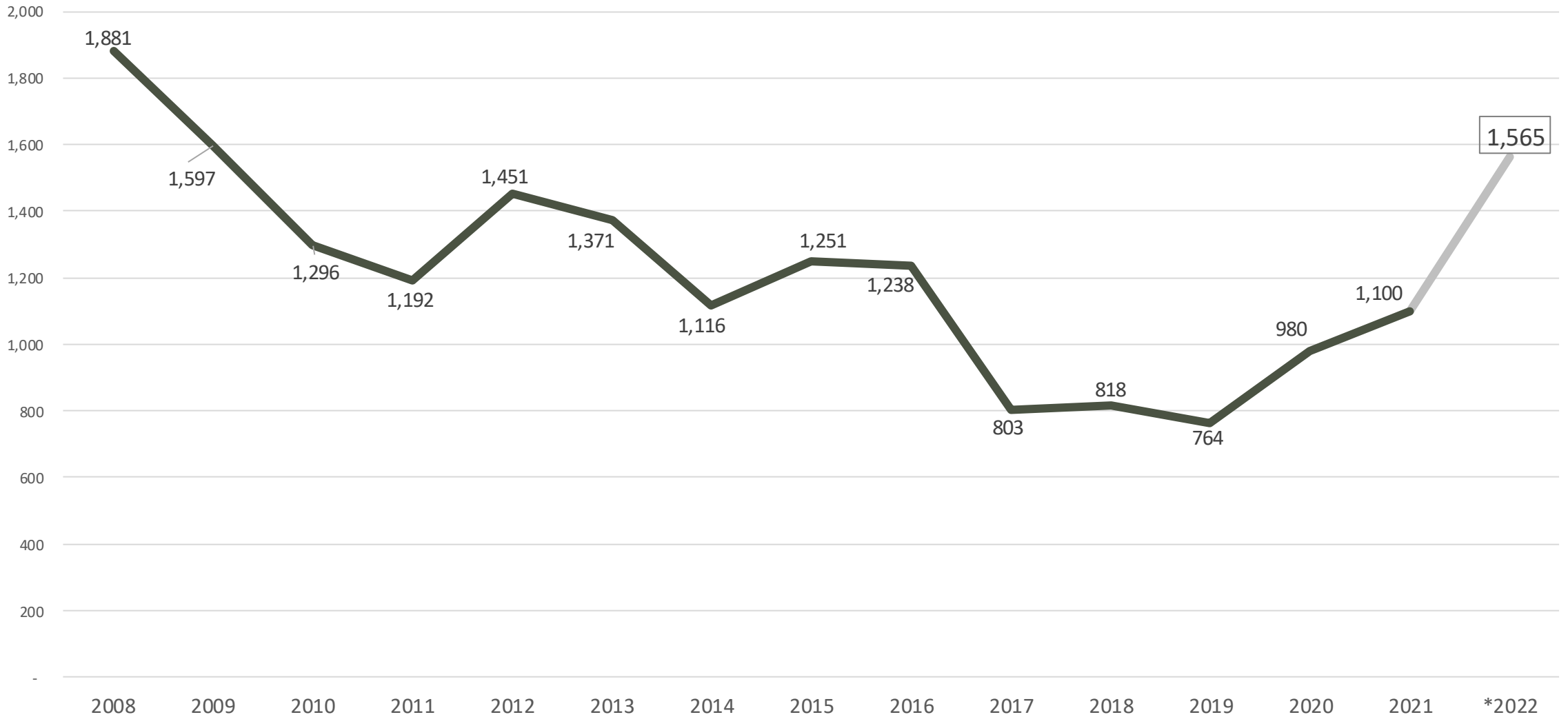

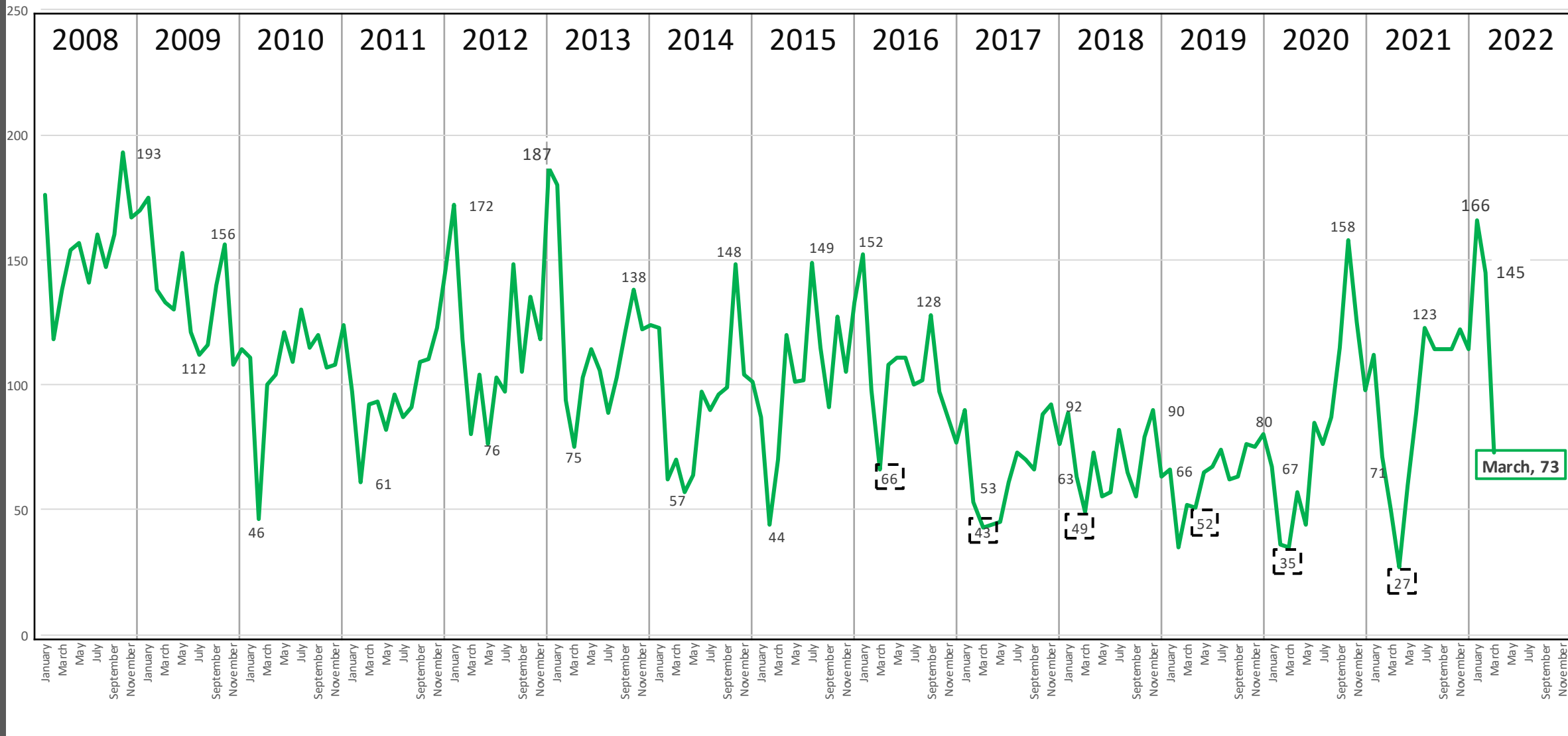

Robbery Gun Counts By Year: 2008-2022



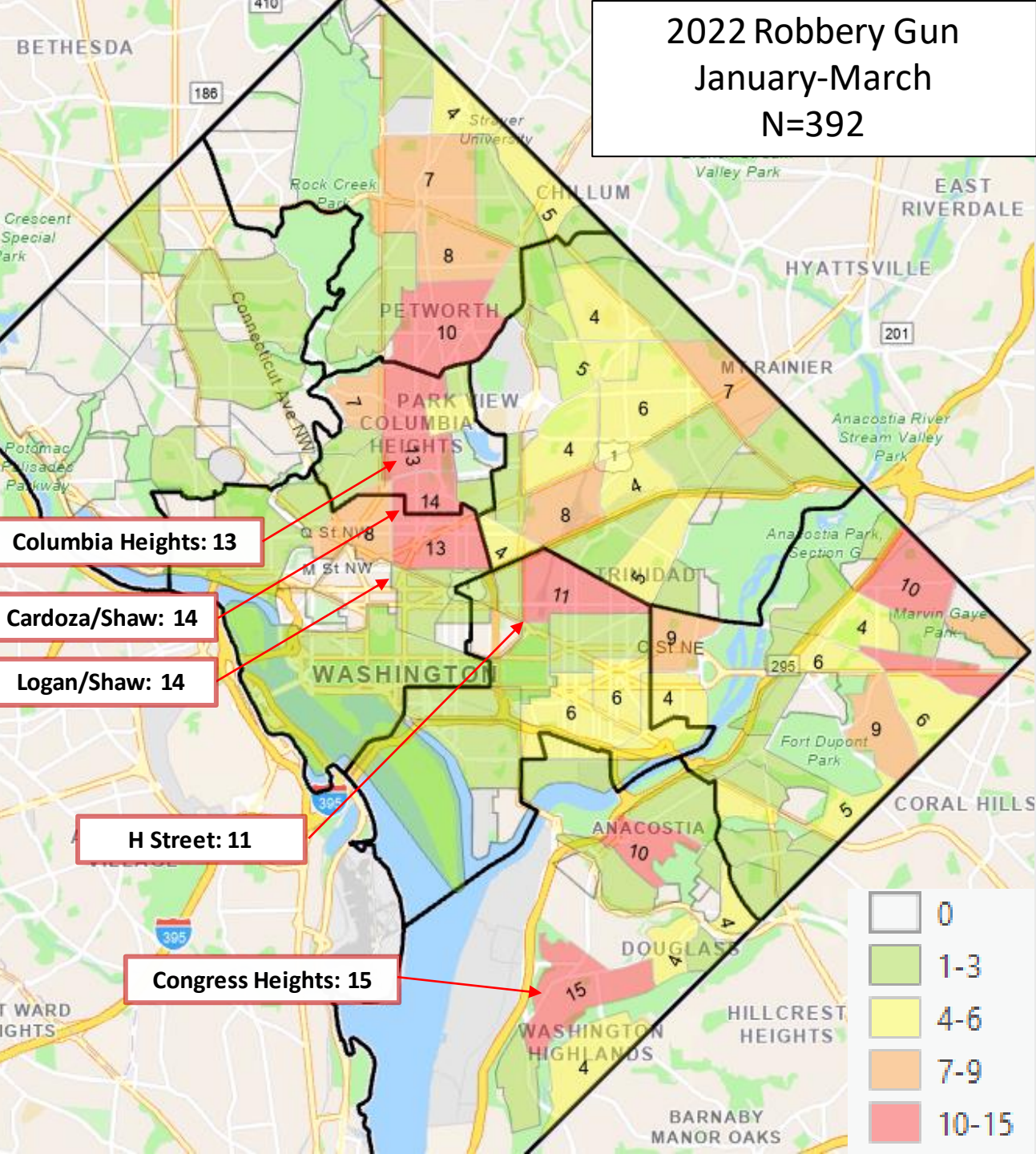
In 2022 Gun Robberies Have Increased 68% Compared to January –March of 2021

Robbery (Gun) By Month: 2008-2021

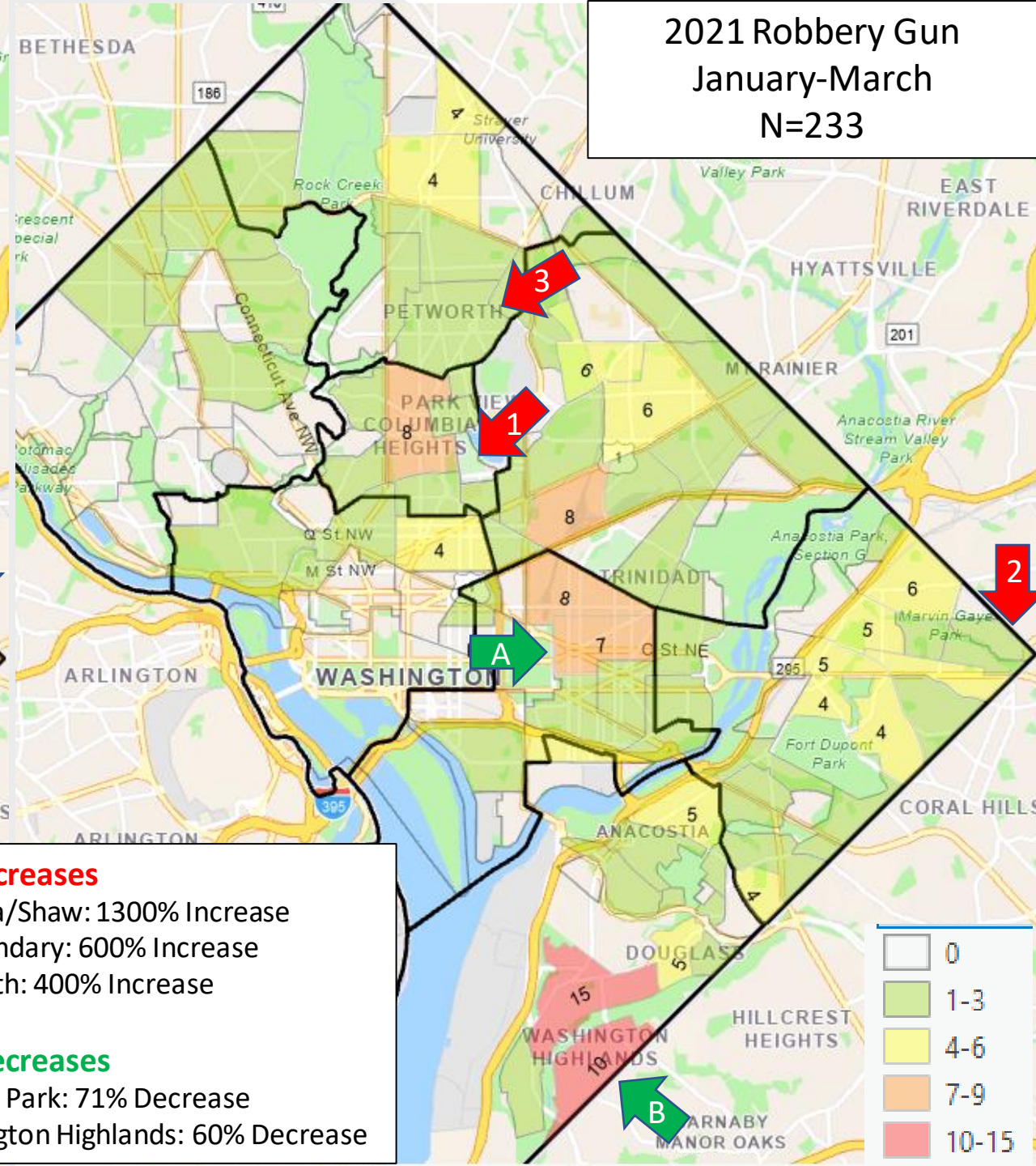
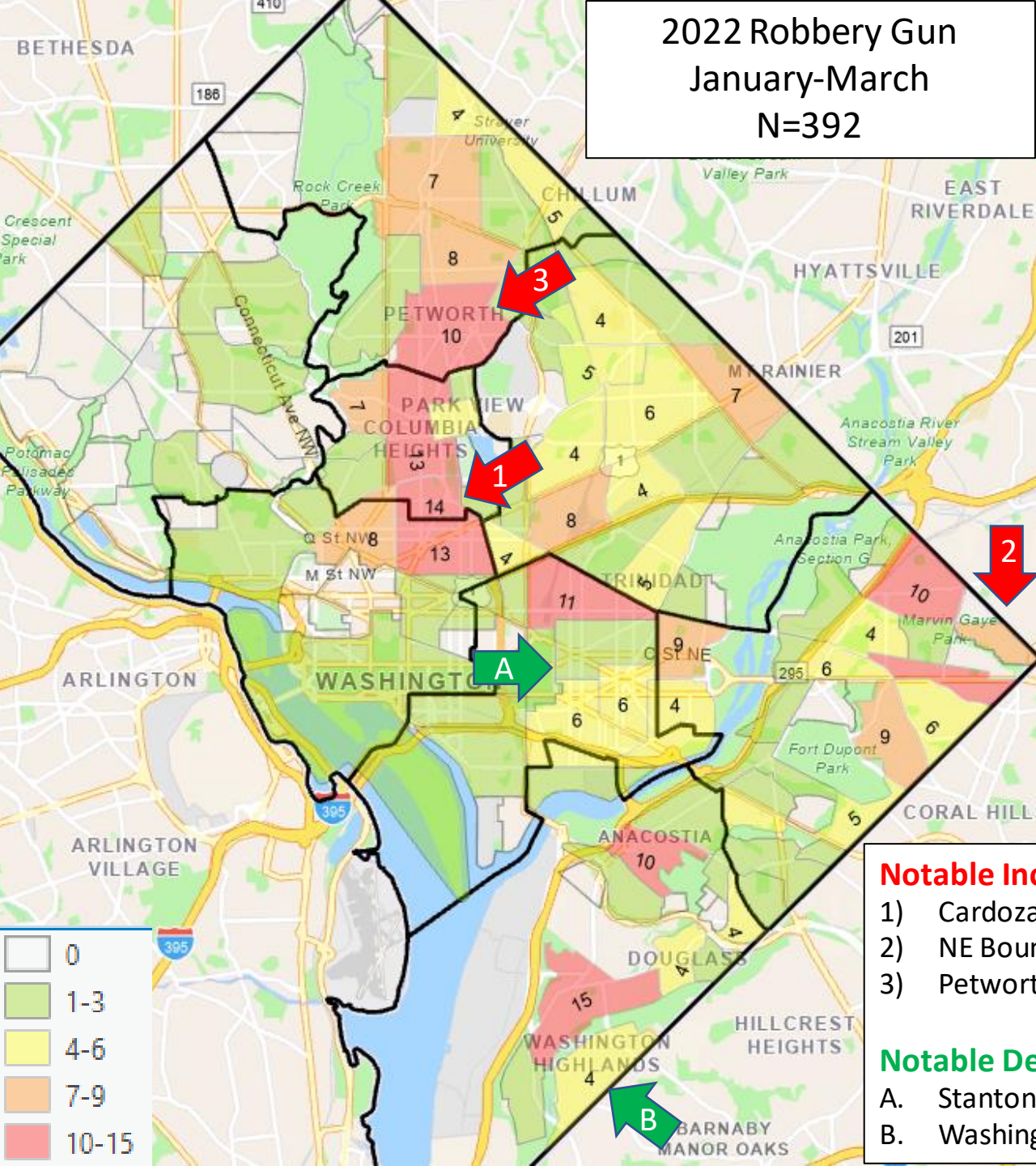

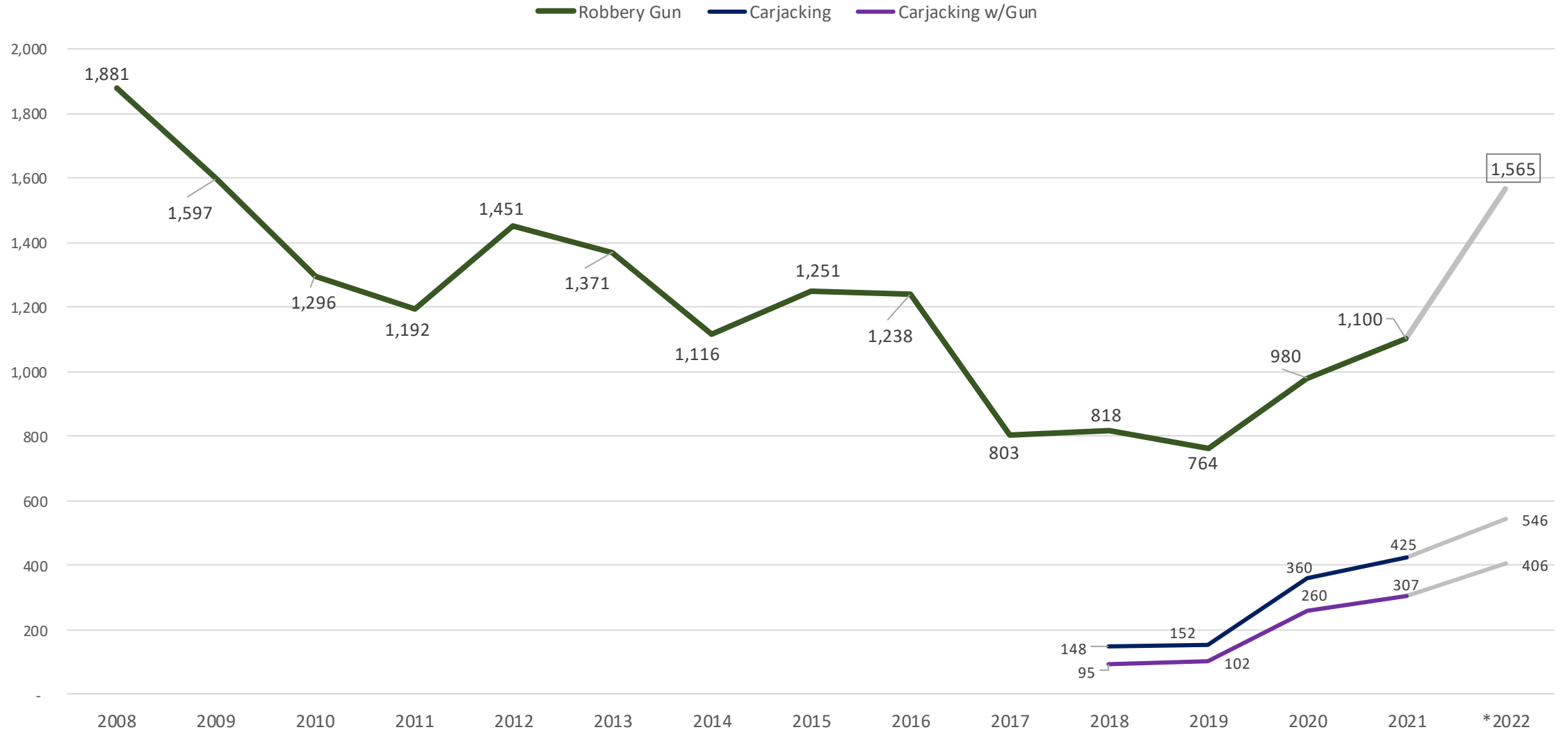

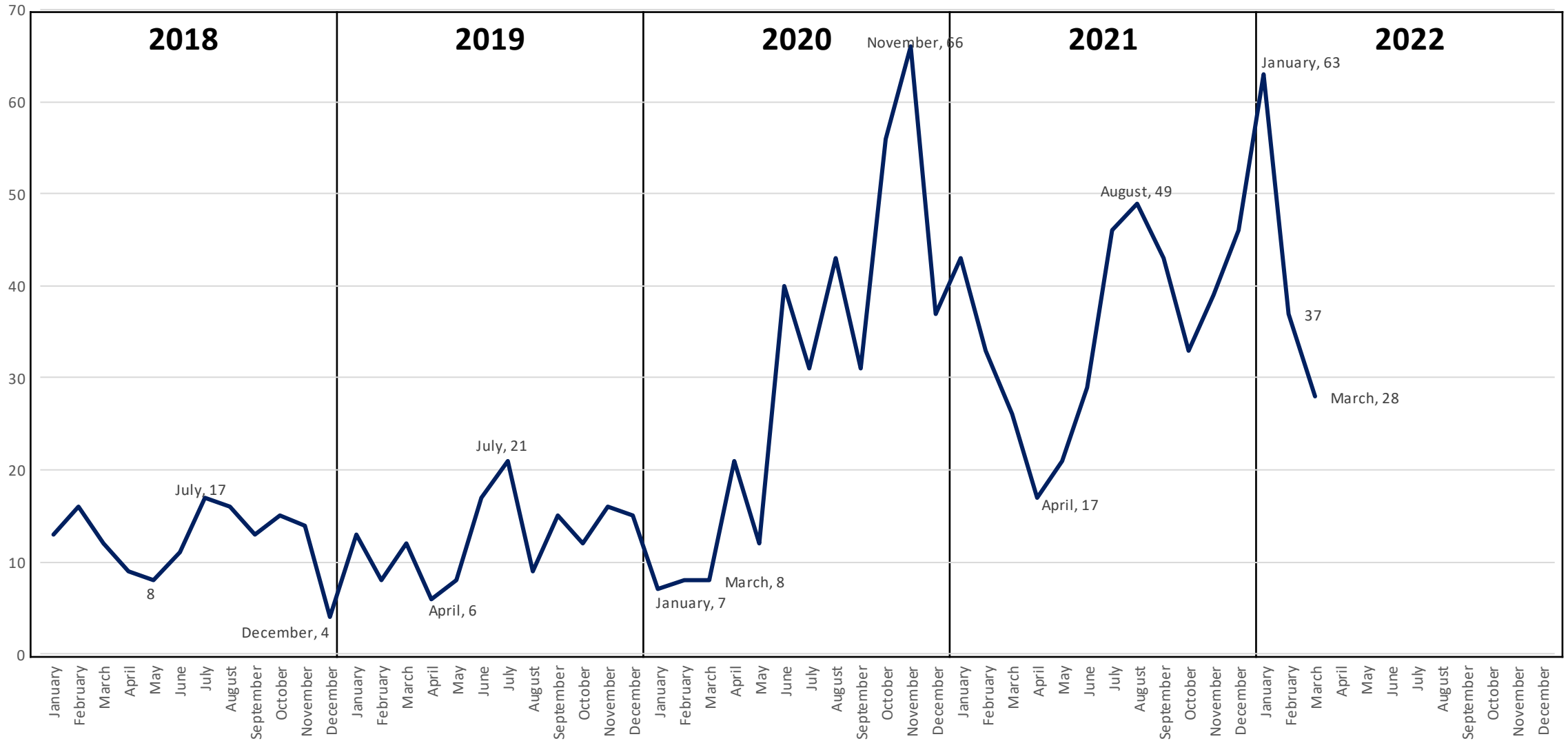
- A. Stanton Park: 71% Decrease

Robbery Gun and Carjacking Counts By Year: 2008-2022



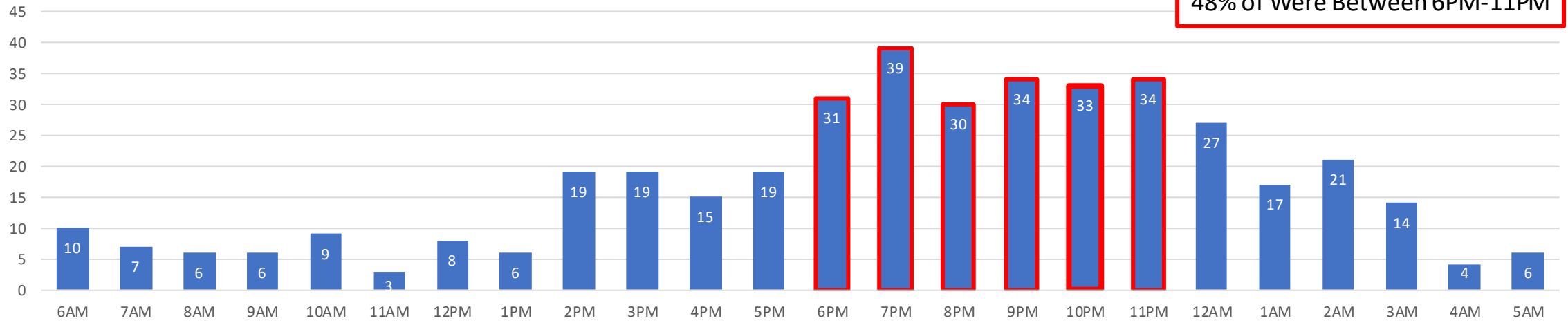
Carjacking Counts By Month: 2018-2022



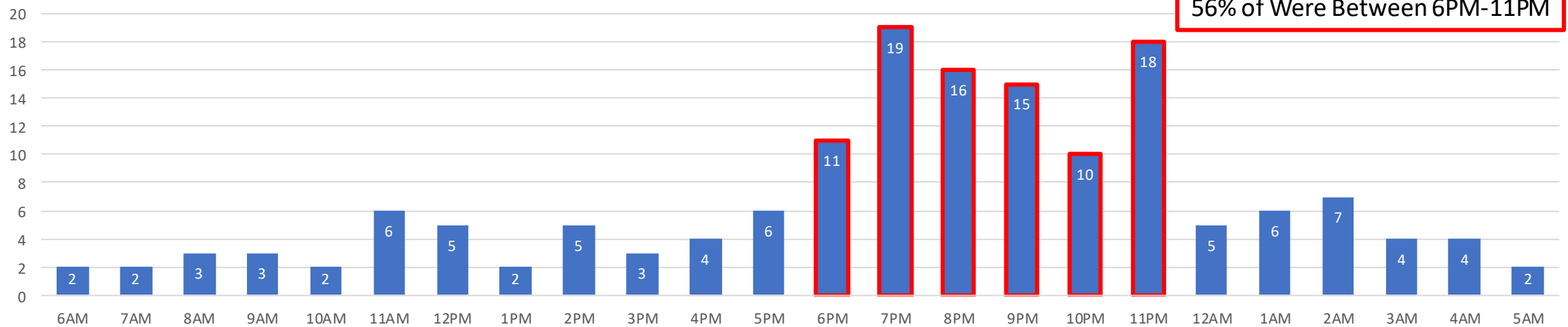

2022 Carjackings By Time of Day

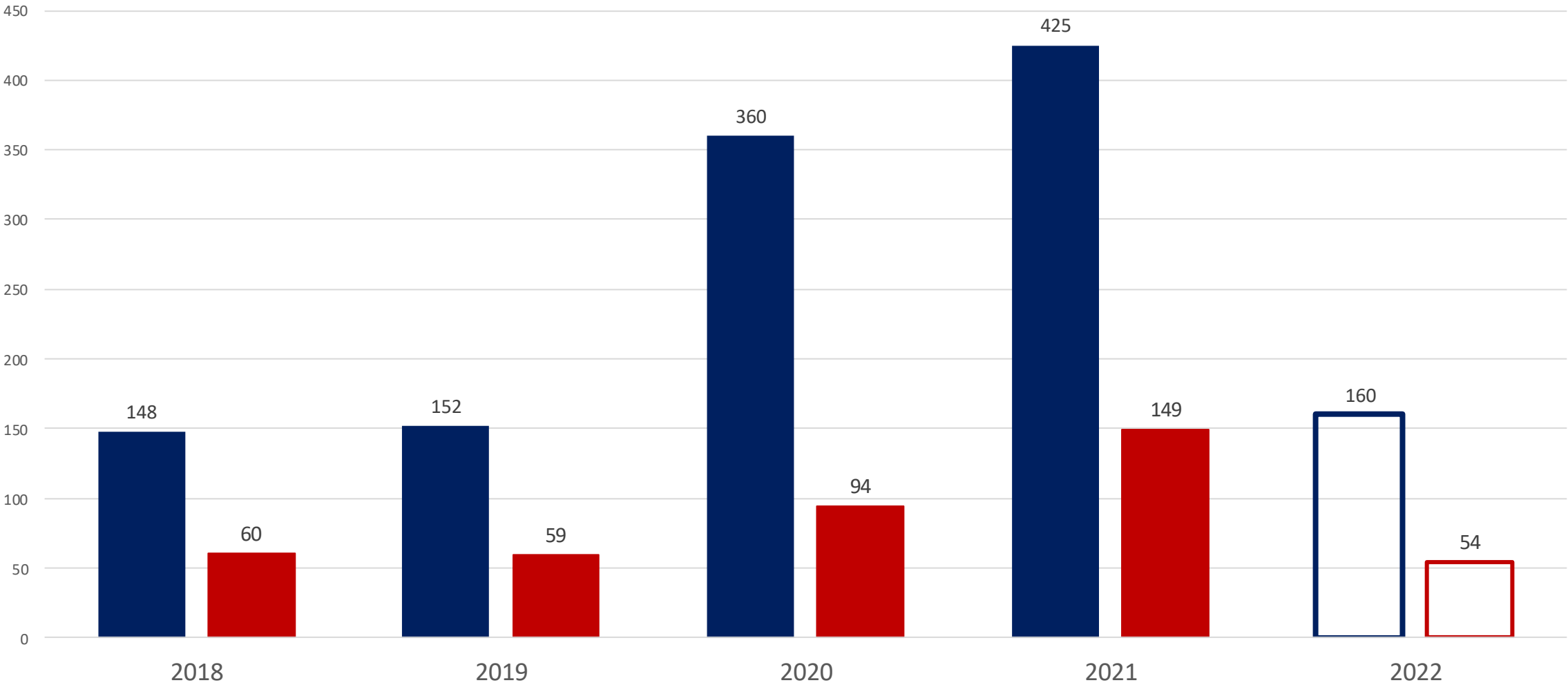

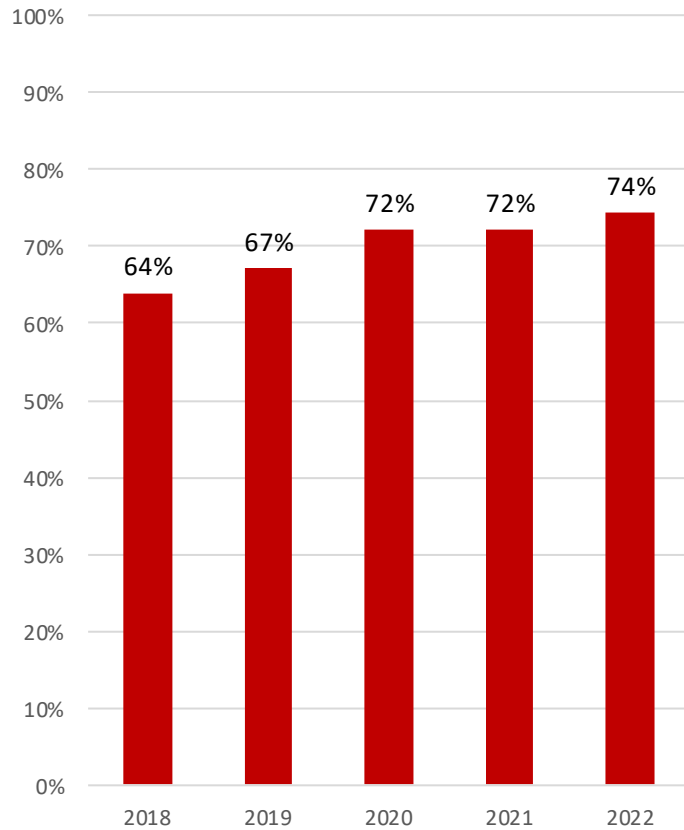

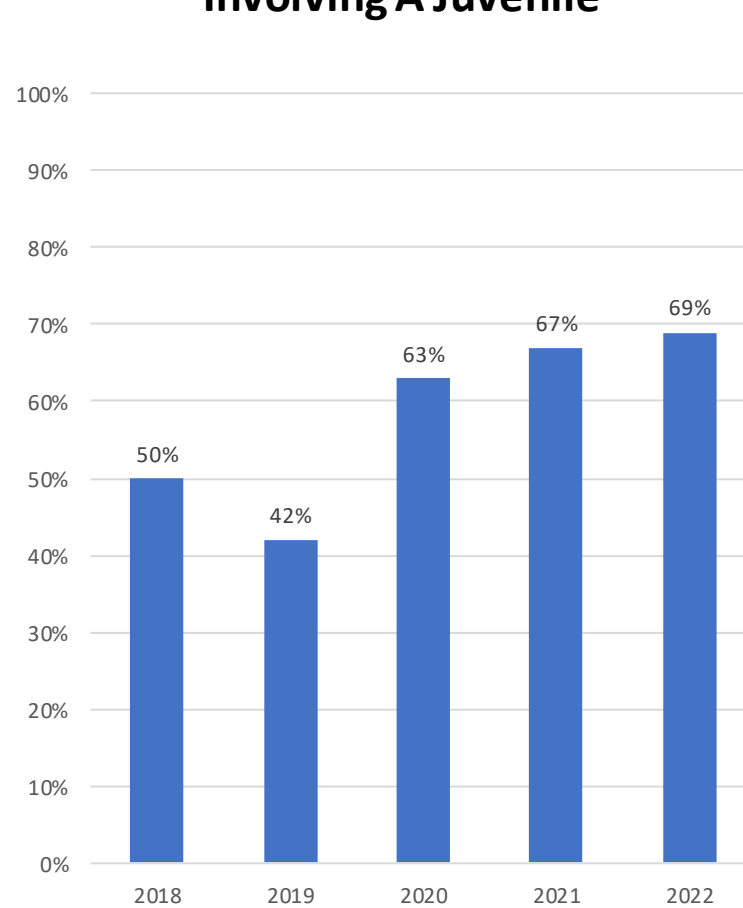

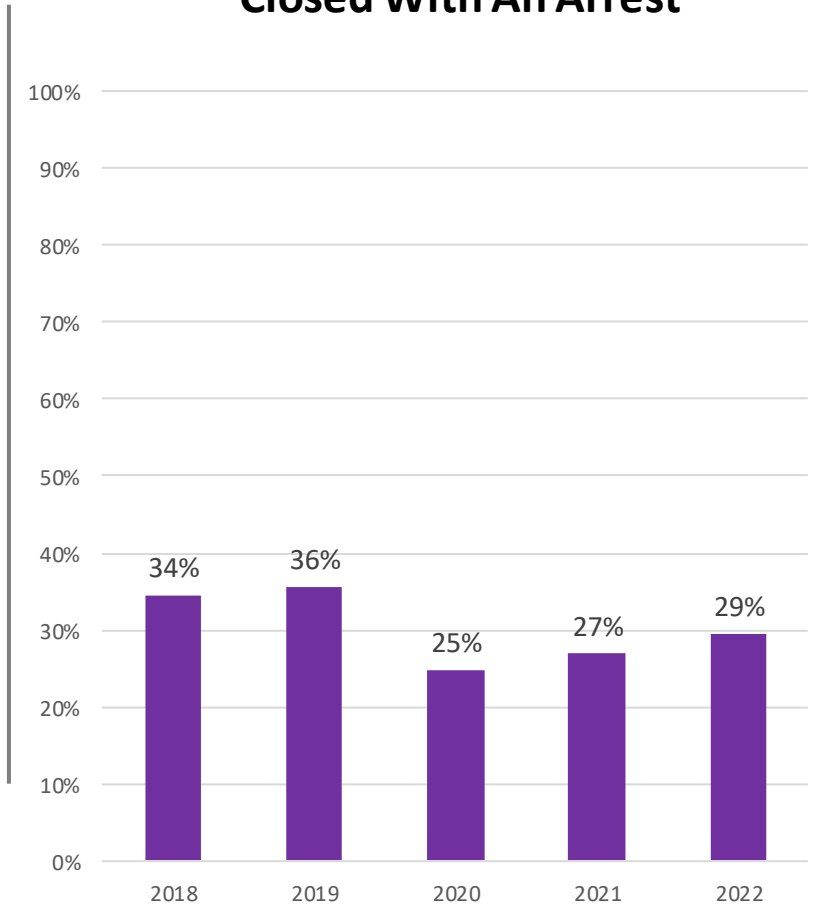
Percent of Carjackings Involving a Gun



Percent of Arrests Involving A Juvenile

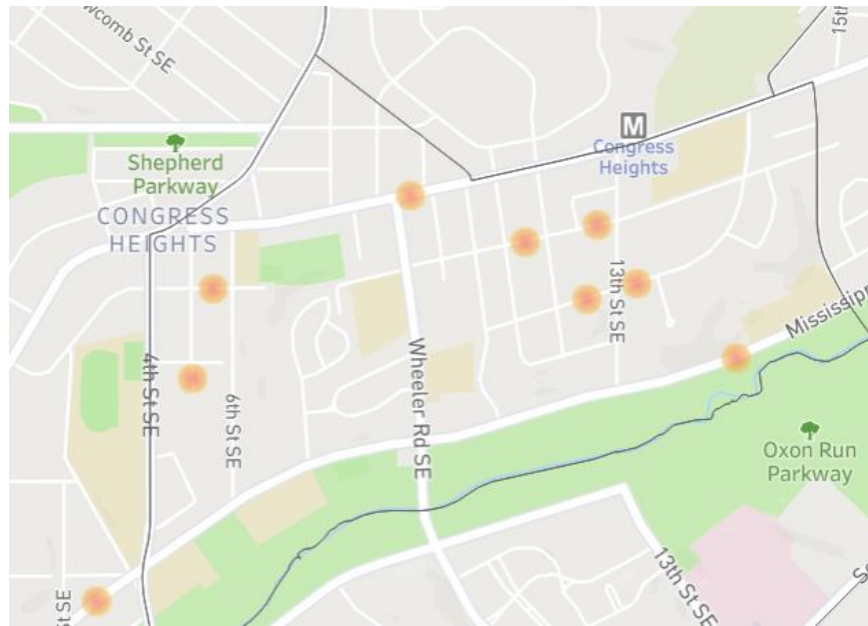


Percent of Carjackings Closed With An Arrest

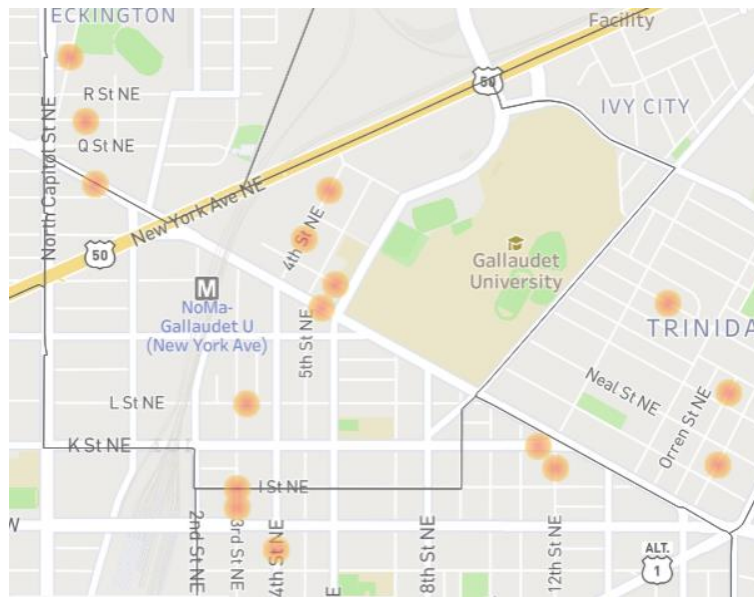

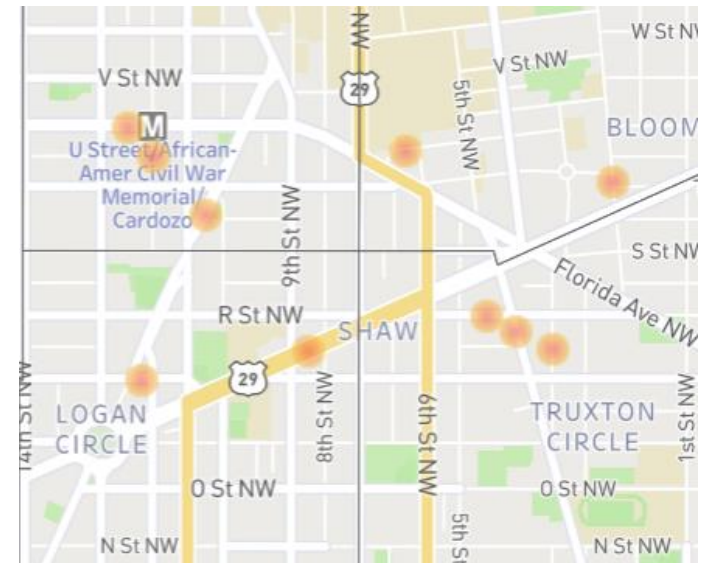

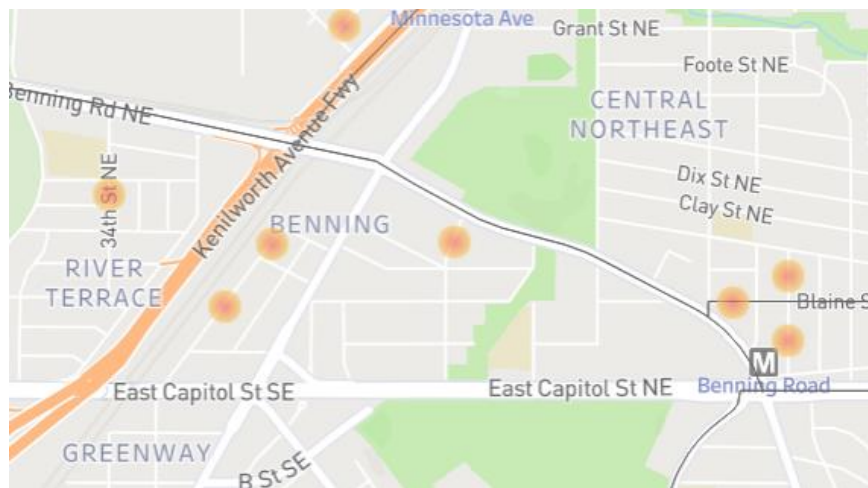

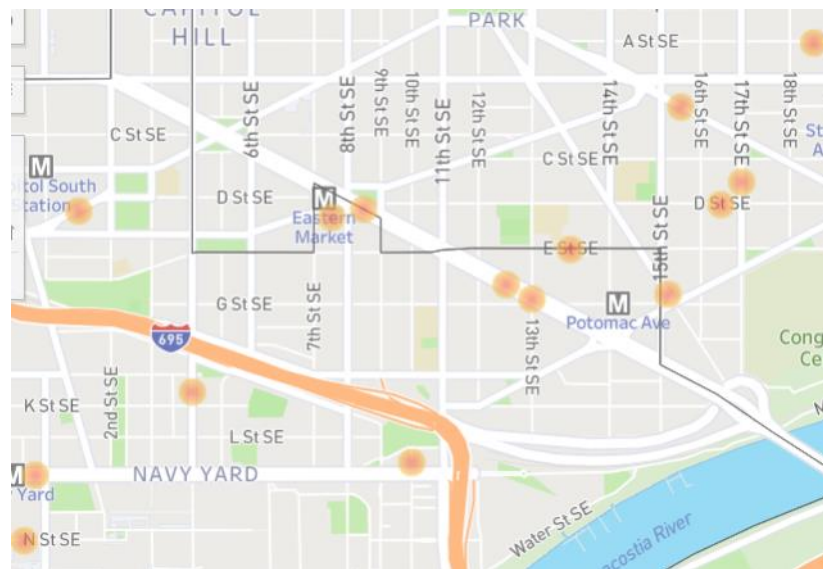
